RESOLUTION NO. 2006-129

A RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY URGING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR
ERIC C. CODILLA, TO ACTIVATE THE OFFICE OF THE SENIOR
CITIZENS AFFAIRS (OSCA) AS A REGULAR OFFICE IN
CONSONANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 6 OF REP. ACT
NO. 7432 AS AMENDED BY REP. ACT NO. 9257.

WHEREAS, Section 6 of Rep. Act No. 7432, otherwise known as "AN ACT
TO MAXIMIZE THE CONTRIBUTION OF SENIOR CITIZENS TO NATION BUILDING,
GRANTS BENEFITS AND SPECIAL PRIVILEGES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES" as
amended by Rep. Act No. 9257, provides:

"Sec. 6. The Office for Senior Citizens Affairs (OSCA)- There
shall be established in all cities and municipalities an OSCA to be
headed by a senior citizen who shall be appointed by the mayor for
a term of three (3) years without reappointment from a list of
three (3) nominees of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or Sangguniang
Bayan. The head of the OSCA shall be assisted by the City Social
Welfare and Development Officer or the municipal social welfare and
development officer, in coordination with the Social Welfare and
Development Office".

"The Office of the Mayor shall exercise supervision over OSCA
relative to their plans, activities and programs for senior
citizens. The OSCA shall work together and establish linkages with
accredited NGOs, POs, and the barangays in their respective areas X
X X".

WHEREAS, aforecited Section 6 of the law, likewise enumerates the
functions of OSCA, among which are:

- (e) To monitor compliance of the provisions of this Act particularly the grant of special discounts and privileges to senior citizens;
- (f) To report to the mayor, establishment found violating any provision of this Act, and

- (g) To assist the senior citizens in filing complaints or charges against any establishment, institution, or agency refusing to comply with the privileges under this Act before the Department of Justice or the provincial, city or municipal trial court".

WHEREAS, per letter dated April 11, 2006 of Regional Director of DBM, addressed to the Hon. Eric C. Codilla, City Mayor, among others states: "As further clarified by the DBM OPCCB (Organization, Position Classification and Compensation Bureau) per Memo dated August 22, 2005, the OSCA may therefore be considered a regular office in the local government unit (LGU), in which case the classification of the head of OSCA will be dependent on the organizational level of the office as determined by the LGU concerned, based on Civil Service Commission Memorandum Circular No. 19, series of 19992."

WHEREAS, the establishment of OSCA as a regular office will encourage the head thereof who is a senior citizen to see to it that the provisions of Rep. Act No. 7432 as amended by Rep. Act No. 9257 are complied with, particularly the grant of special discounts and privileges to senior citizens;

WHEREAS, the Sanggunian on October 31, 2004, passed a Resolution NO. 2004-097, entitled: "A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING TO THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR, ERIC C. CODILLA, THE NAMES OF THREE NOMINEES TO HEAD THE OFFICE OF SENIOR CITIZENS AFFAIRS, NAMELY 1) Mr. Asisclo S. Fiel; 2) Mr. Cesar Into; 3) Ms. Editha Villaluz;

WHEREFORE, foregoing premises considered, on motion of City Councilor Mariano Y. Corro, Chairman, Committee on Ordinances, jointly seconded by City Councilors Claudio P. Larrazabal & Sotero M. Pepito; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass a resolution RESPECTFULLY URGING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR ERIC C. CODILLA TO ACTIVATE THE OFFICE OF THE SENIOR CITIZENS AFFAIRS (OSCA) AS A REGULAR OFFICE IN CONSONANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 6 OF REP. ACT NO. 7432 AS AMENDED BY REP. ACT NO. 9257;


