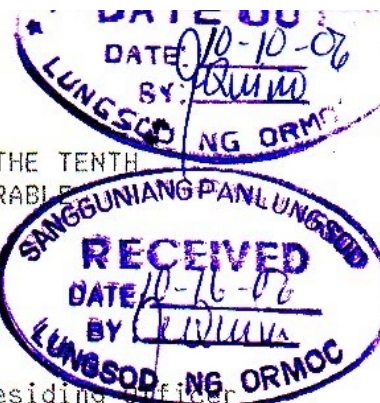

A RESOLUTION FAVORABLY INDORSING TO THE NATIONAL
HISTORICAL INSTITUTE THE REQUEST OF THE SANGGUNIANG
BARANGAY OF SAN JOSE ORMOC CITY, THE PTCA, FACULTY CLUB
AND THE SUPREME STUDENT GOVERNMENT OF SAN JOSE NATIONAL
HIGH SCHOOL, SAN JOSE, THIS CITY FOR THE RENAMING OF
SAID SCHOOL TO GENARO B. LUREÑANA MEMORIAL NATIONAL
HIGH SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian is in receipt of 2nd Indorsement dated 24
July 2006 from the Office of the City Mayor re: request of the
Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay San Jose, PTCA, Faculty Club and the
Supreme Student Government of San Jose National High School for the
renaming of said School to Genaro B. Lureñana Memorial National High
School;

WHEREAS, the Genaro Lureñana Clan of San Jose, this city, through
an undated letter has also requested for the renaming of San Jose
National High to Genaro B. Lureñana Memorial High School citing in said
letter the resume of the late Genaro B. Lureñana together with his
achievements as the Barrio founder who was known for his generosity and
kindness; (Copy of said letter is hereto attached as ANNEX "A")

WHEREAS, Section 13 Par. (b) of Republic Act 7160, otherwise known
as the Local Government Code of 1991, in part provided that:

"(b) The Sanggunian of highly urbanized cities and component cities
whose charters prohibit their voters from voting for provincial
elective officials herein after referred to in this code as
Independent Component Cities, may in consultation with the
Philippine Historical Commission, change the name of the following
within its territorial jurisdiction

(3) Public elementary, secondary and vocational or technical schools, community, colleges and non-chartered colleges" (Emphasis supplies).
