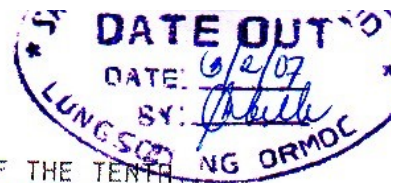
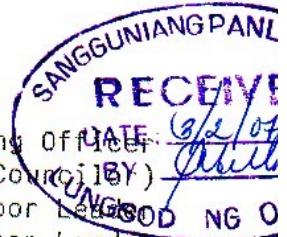

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-039

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PROPOSED 2.6 HECTARES
RECLAMATION PROJECT OF THE PHILIPPINE PORTS AUTHORITY,
THIS CITY, SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS, TO WIT:

- A) THAT THE PPA WILL RECLAIM AN ADDITIONAL 2 HECTARES
FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENT UTILIZATION AND SHALL BE DONE
SIMULTANEOUSLY;
- B) AND THAT PRIOR TO THE FINAL APPROVAL OF SAID PLAN,
THE DETAILED ENGINEERING WORKS SHOULD BE PRESENTED
TO THE ORMOC CITY GOVERNMENT FOR CONFORMITY;

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian is in receipt of a 1st Indorsement dated January 31, 2007 from the Honorable City Mayor Eric C. Codilla urgently requesting for the passage of a resolution approving the preliminary request on the proposed development project of the Philippine Ports Authority (PPA) provided:

- a) that the PPA will reclaim an additional 2 hectares for local government utilization and shall be done simultaneously;
- b) and that prior to the final approval of said plan, the detailed Engineering Works should be presented to the Ormoc City Government for conformity;

WHEREAS, the proposed reclamation project of the Philippine Ports Authority will provide additional Roro facilities, adequate back-up area for roro and rolling cargoes, a passenger terminal complex housing the Port Integrated Clearing Office (PICO), a sort of a one stop shop aimed to provide a customer friendly and hassle free transaction at the port, and most importantly, an ample area for the use of the City Government of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, this august Body believes that the proposed reclamation project will help boost the Tourism, Industry of Ormoc City and is in line with the Local Government's thrust to provide the best facilities and services to the Ormocanons including that of the neighboring cities and towns, hence, the same be accorded due course of action;

WHEREFORE, on motion of City Councilor Claudio P. Larrazabal, Chairman, Committee on Transportation & Communications, severally seconded by City Councilors Mariano Y. Corro, Fe S. Lladoc & Eduardo P. Tan; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass a resolution APPROVING THE PROPOSED 2.6 HECTARES RECLAMATION PROJECT OF THE PHILIPPINE PORTS AUTHORITY, THIS CITY, SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS, TO WIT:

- A) THAT THE PPA WILL RECLAIM AN ADDITIONAL 2 HECTARES FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENT UTILIZATION AND SHALL BE DONE SIMULTANEOUSLY;
- B) AND THAT PRIOR TO THE FINAL APPROVAL OF SAID PLAN, THE DETAILED ENGINEERING WORKS SHOULD BE PRESENTED TO THE ORMOC CITY GOVERNMENT FOR CONFORMITY;




