A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING HOUSE BILL NO. 1755 INTRODUCED BY REPRESENTATIVE EUFROCINO M. CODILLA, SR. 4TH DISTRICT OF LEYTE ENTITLED: "AN ACT AMENDING REPUBLIC ACT NO. 8379 TO BE KNOWN AS "AN ACT SEPARATING THE NEW ORMOC 8379 TO BE KNOWN AS "AN ACT SEPARATING THE DESCRIPTION OF AN ACT SEPARATING THE DESCRIPTION OF ACT O EASTERN VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY-ORMOC CITY SCHOOL OF ARTS AND TRADE (EVSU-OCSAT).

WHEREAS, the conversion of the Ormoc City High School (OCHS) Barangay Don Felipe Larrazabal, Ormoc City into the Ormoc City School of Arts and Trade (OCSAT) in 1997 by operation of Republic Act No. 8379 was already defective from the beginning;

WHEREAS, Ormoc City High School had a total enrollment of 3359 during the school year when the school was converted into a School of Arts and Trade in 1997;

WHEREAS, when Ormoc City School of Arts and Trade (OCSAT) started to operate in SY 1998-99 the school admitted only a limited number of High School enrollees enough to maintain a High School Laboratory class for their 8S Industrial Arts and Industrial Education Course offerings, thus, causing the dislocation of more than 3,000 students who were enrolled during the year when the conversion of the said school was made:

WHEREAS, to provide an immediate solution to the problem of students dislocation, a new high school was organized now called as the New Ormoc City National High School (NOCNHS) occupying the same campus and buildings presently taken over by Ormoc City School of Arts and Trade (OCSAT) and managed by Eastern Visayas State University by the operation of Republic Act No. 9311 giving the Eastern Visayas State University (EVSU) the Administrative and Supervisory Control over Ormoc City School of Arts and Trade;

WHEREAS, as a result of these developments, the New Ormoc City National High School is now considered a squatter in its own property;

WHEREAS, the increasing enrollment in both schools, namely, the New Ormoc City National High School (NOCNHS) and Ormoc City School of Arts and Trade- Eastern Visayas State University (EVSU-OCSAT) year will eventually cause students congestion in the present campus;

WHEREAS, the problem of overcrowding both in the classrooms and in the school campus will surely have an adverse effect on the delivery of educational services to the student population of the two (2) schools, thus, violating their rights to quality education enshrined in Sec. 1 Article XIV of the 1987 Philippine Constitution;

WHEREAS, the recognition of this rights to quality education demands that appropriate steps be taken to make quality education accessible to all (Sec. 1 Article XIV, Phil. Constitution);

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc fully enderses and supports the present initiative of Congressman Eufrocino M. Codilla, Sr, of the 4th District of Leyte of introducing House Bill No. 1755 which sought to amend Republic Act No. 8379 known as "AN ACT SERARATING THE NEW ORMOC CITY NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL (NOCHHS) IN BARANGAY DON FELIPE LARRAZABAL ORMOC CITY FROM THE ORMOC CITY SCHOOL OF ARTS AND TRADE (OCSAT) NOW UNDER THE NEW NAME EVSU-OCSAT;

WHEREFORE, FOREGOING PREMISES CONSIDERED, on MASS MOTION of the Body; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING HOUSE BILL NO. 1755 INTRODUCED BY REPRESENTATIVE EUFROCINO M.
