WHEREAS, on April 30, 2003 the 9th Sangguniang Panlungsod adopted an ordinance ordaining the codification of the general ordinances of the City of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, after the adoption and approval of the Code of General Ordinances of the City of Ormoc, general ordinances which were thereafter adopted and approved were not incorporated in the Code;

WHEREAS, through inadvertence, there were also ordinances inadvertently not included in the codification;

WHEREAS, there is a need to incorporate said ordinances into the Code of General Ordinances if only to update the existing code;

WHEREFORE, FOREGOING PREMISES CONSIDERED, on motion of City Councilor Mariano Y. Corro, Chairman, Committee on Laws and Ordinances, severally seconded by City Councilors Ruben R. Capahi, Sotero M. Pepito and Gregorio A. Yrastorza, Jr.; be it
