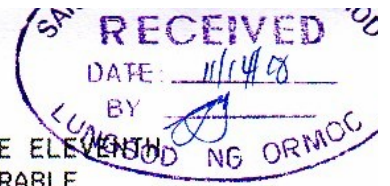

A RESOLUTION URGING ALL THE BANKS AND FINANCIAL
INTERMEDIARIES LOCATED WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF ORMOC
CITY TO PUT UP/INSTALL SECURITY CAMERAS/CCTVS IN THEIR
RESPECTIVE ESTABLISHMENTS.

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian is in receipt of a memorandum from P/SUPT
Leo Estavillo Quevedo of the PNP, NPC, 8th Regional Criminal
Investigation and Detection Group dated November 03, 2008, re:
Coordination with LGU's re-installation of CCTV's in Banking
Institutions;

WHEREAS, said memorandum directs local police to persuade the LGU's
to come up with an ordinance requiring all banks in their respective
localities to have CCTV cameras and alarm system installed in compliance
with BSP Memorandum Circular 620;

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian believes that a Resolution is more
appropriate rather than an Ordinance;

WHEREAS, the use of modern technology for curbing crimes is the
prime need of the hour. Installing Close Circuit Television (CCTV)
cameras could be used in preventing anti-social activities and object
analysis to cut crime, allowing for the fast distribution and analysis
of recorded images necessary for the banks and establishment to be
protected which can then be remotely distributed to police or security
on the ground;

WHEREAS, this august Body believes that said request is reasonable,
hence, the same be accorded due course of action;

WHEREFORE, FOREGOING PREMISES CONSIDERED, on MASS MOTION of the
Body; be it


RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass a resolution URGING ALL THE BANKS AND FINANCIAL INTERMEDIARIES LOCATED WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF ORMOC CITY TO PUT UP/INSTALL SECURITY CAMERAS/CCTVS IN THEIR RESPECTIVE ESTABLISHMENTS;
