A RESOLUTION FAVORABLY ENDORSING TO THE OFFICE OF THE DENR-CENRO, ALBUERA, LEYTE, THE REQUEST OF THE RESPECTIVE BARANGAY COUNCILS OF LAO, NAUNGAN, AND SAN JUAN, ORMOC CITY FOR THE CREATION OF A COMPOSITE SURVEY TEAM TO CONDUCT A DELINEATION SURVEY OF THE WHOLE 191-MANGROVE FOREST WITH RESPECT TO THE EXISTING FISHPONDS WITHIN THE TERRITORIES OF SAID BARANGAYS.

WHEREAS, the Eleventh Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc has received a communication dated December 8, 2009 from Engr. Juliana P. Flores, Supervising Env'l. Management Specialist, ENRD, in connection with the respective Barangay Resolutions of Lao, Naungan, and San Juan, this city, all requesting the Office of the DENR-CENRO to create a composite survey team that will conduct a delineation survey of the entire mangrove forest with respect to the existing fishponds within the territories of said barangays;

WHEREAS, based on the records of the Community Environment and Natural Resources Office (CENRO) and in the Community Based Forestry Management (CBFM) Agreement the mangrove covers an area of 191 hectares;

WHEREAS, the conduct of a delineation survey is deemed necessary in order to determine the boundary lines between timberland, alienable & disposable (A & D) land, and the area covered by the Community Based Forestry Management (CBFM) Project;

WHEREAS, the proliferation of illegal fishpond cultivators in the aforementioned barangays is allegedly rampant hence, there is a need to initiate measures to control such illegal activities in order to save and maintain balance of our existing mangrove resources;

WHEREAS, the mangrove is one of the important sources of marine biodiversity and supplies food for marine life and is the habitat of vrious marine species;

WHEREAS, this august Body finds the said request to be reasonable and beneficial to the residents of the aforementioned barangays;

WHEREFORE, FOREGOING PREMISES CONSIDERED, on motion of City Councilor Jose C. Alfaro, Jr., Chairman, Committee on Natural Resources and Environmental Control, severally seconded by City Councilors Claudio P. Larrazabal, Sotero M. Pepito, Rafael C. Omega, Jr. and Fernando P. Parrilla; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass a resolution FAVORABLY ENDORSING TO THE OFFICE OF THE DENR-CENRO, ALBUERA, LEYTE, THE REQUEST OF THE RESPECTIVE BARANGAY COUNCILS OF LAO, NAUNGAN, AND SAN JUAN, ORMOC CITY FOR THE CREATION OF A COMPOSITE SURVEY TEAM TO CONDUCT A DELINEATION SURVEY OF THE WHOLE 191-MANGROVE FOREST WITH RESPECT TO THE EXISTING FISHPONDS WITHIN THE TERRITORIES OF SAID BARANGAYS;
