A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR
ERIC C. CODILLA TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE
MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) FOR AND IN BEHALF
OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF ORMOC WITH THE ORMOC
CITY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY (OCCCI).

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian is in receipt of an Indorsement dated January 20, 2011 from the Office of the City Mayor requesting for the passage of a resolution authorizing the Honorable City Mayor Eric C. Codilla to enter into and sign a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) for and in behalf of the City Government of Ormoc with the Ormoc City Chamber of Commerce & Industry (OCCCI);

WHEREAS, the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) refers to the implementation of the Working for the Enhancement of the Chamber and Association Network in the Visayas and Caraga (WE CAN Visayas & Caraga) referred to as THE PROJECT which aim is to improve the business environment for small and medium sized enterprise (SME) development in the partnership region and sectors in the Visayas and Caraga;

WHEREAS, the aforementioned MOA mentions that the OCCCI in support of the City's economic development thrusts has selected Tourism as its focus sector in the implementation of the WE CAN project's Sector Unit approach and agreed to participate and cooperate in the planning, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of the Project.




