RESOLUTION NO. 2011-078

A RESOLUTION DECLARING AS PATRIMONIAL PROPERTIES OF  
LGU ORMOC CITY THE ABANDONED EXECUTIVE AND  
LEGISLATIVE BUILDINGS AS THEY ARE NO LONGER NEEDED  
FOR PUBLIC USE OR SERVICE.

WHEREAS, LGU Ormoc City has a new, modern and spacious City Hall located at  
Brgy. Cogon, Ormoc city;

WHEREAS, the EXECUTIVE AND LEGISLATIVE Bldgs. located at the waterfront,  
and which used to house the different offices of the City Government of Ormoc are no longer  
needed for public use or service as the new City Hall can practically accommodate all the offices  
of the City Government;

WHEREAS, Article 422 of the Civil Code of the Philippines, provides:

"Property of public dominion, when no longer intended for public use or for  
public service, shall form part of the patrimonial property of the state".

WHEREAS, "Property of public dominion ceases to be such and becomes private  
property of the same only upon a declaration by the government, through the executive or  
legislative departments to the effect that it is no longer needed for public use or service (See  
Civil Code of the Philippines, vol. II, page 39, Tolentino, citing the cases of Ignacio vs. Director  
of Lands, (S.C.) 58 Off. Gaz. 2403; Cebu Oxygen and Acetylene Co. Vs. Bercilles, 66 scra 48)
