A RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR EDWARD C. CODILLA TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF TRADE AND INDUSTRY -REGION VIII, REPRESENTED BY ITS REGIONAL DIRECTOR CYNTHIA VIERRAS, FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE GRASSROOTS PARTICIPATORY BUDGETING **PROJECTS** THIS CITY IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED SIXTY THOUSAND PHILIPPINE PESOS ONLY (PHP3,760,000.00).

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian received an Indorsement dated June 20, 2014 from the Office of the City Mayor relative to the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to be signed and entered into by the Local Government Unit of Ormoc (LGU-Ormoc) and the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) - Region VIII, represented by its Regional Director Cynthia Nierras, for the Implementation of Grassroots Participatory Budgeting (GBP) projects in this City amounting to THREE MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED SIXTY THOUSAND PHILIPPINE PESOS ONLY (PHP3,760,000.00);

WHEREAS, in the Indorsement it is further requested that the Honorable City Mayor Edward C. Codilla be granted the authority to sign the aforementioned MOA for and in behalf of the LGU-Ormoc, a photocopy of the final MOA and its attachments, namely, the Project Proposal and the Work and Financial Plan submitted by the City Agricultural Office (CAO) this City, of which are hereto attached and made integral parts hereof;

WHEREAS, DTI is identified as one of the participating agencies in the implementation of the GBP Projects, previously known as Bottom-up Budgeting (BuB), for CY 2014, while LGU-Ormoc as the partner LGU is identified as one of the recipients of a GPB approved project that is included in the DTI's budget under the General Appropriations Act (GAA) for FY 2014, and is eligible to implement the same as evaluated by DTI subject to the Policy Guidelines and Procedure in the Implementation of BuB for the FY 2014 budget preparation as provided in Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) No.3 Series of 2012 of DBM-DILG-DSWD-NAPC;

WHEREAS, paragraph 5.10.1 of DBM-DILG-DSWD-NAPC JMC No. 3 Series of 2012, provides for the criteria that have to be met by recipient LGU in order to be eligible in implementing the BUB projects, as follows:

The LGU is a recipient of Department of Interior and Local Government's (DILG) Seal of Good Housekeeping (SGH) based on the 2013 Assessment;

The LGU has made substantial progress in implementing its Public Financial Management (PFM) Improvement Plan as determined by DBM;

The LGU has the technical capacity to implement the project, as determined by the concerned participating agency (on a per project basis); and,

The LGU has no unliquidated cash advances from participating agencies based on existing auditing rules and regulations (on a per agency basis).

WHEREAS, LGU-Ormoc meets the aforementioned requirements and is qualified to implement priority projects identified by the CAO to be funded under the GPB, to wit:

Integrated Development for Rootcrops Skill	2,240,000.00
Entrepreneurial Development Trainings	1,200,000.00
Total Approved Budget	PHP3,760,000.00

WHEREAS, hence, the MOA stipulates the specific obligations and responsibilities of the concerned parties towards the achievement and implementation of the GPB project, and this Sanggunian finds, after close and thorough review of the MOA, that the same is beneficial to the City, and therefore, most deserving of its utmost support and favorable consideration;
