RESOLUTION NO. 2015-051

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR CODILIA TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN A MENORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC (LGU-ORMOC) WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH (DOH), REPRESENTED BY THE DOH SECRETARY, HON. JANETTE LORETO-GARIN, FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ENHANCED CITY-WIDE INVESTMENT PLAN FOR HEALTH (CIPH) II CY 2014-2016.

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian has received an Indorsement dated March 3, 2015 from the Office of the City Mayor relative to the preceding Indorsement from the City Health Officer II, Dr. Nelita D. Navales, requesting for the passage of a resolution authorizing the Honorable City Mayor to enter and sign the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) by and between the Department of Health (DOH), represented by the DOH Secretary, Hon. Janette Loreto-Garin, and the Local Government Unit of Ormoc for the implementation of the enhanced City-wide Investment Plan for Health (CIPH) II CY 2014-2016, a photocopy of the final MOA is hereto attached and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, the DOH has adopted the "Kalusugan Pangkalahatan" program as the implementation framework for health sector reforms to attain the goals of better health outcomes, more responsive health systems, and equitable health care financing, by pursuing strategic thrusts, as follows:

- 1.) Financial risk protection through expansion in NHIP enrollment and benefit delivery,
- 2.) Improved access to quality hospitals and health care facilities; and
- 3.) Attainment of the health related Millennium Development Goals (MDGs).

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WHEREAS, the CIPH is a local health development program and medium term public investment plan consistent with "Kalusugan Pangkalahatan" principles that shall govern the health operations of LGU-Ormoc and serve as a guide for any action to be undertaken in relation thereon;

WHEREAS, the CIPH is the key instrument in forging DOH and LGU partnership to achieve health sector reform goals embedded in the MDGs and the National Objectives for Health (NOH) in a devolved health system within specified technical standards;

WHEREAS, LGU Ormoc has agreed to fund and implement the programs, projects, and activities under the enhanced CIPH through its own financing sources and available development partners that are coordinated by DOH, as well as agreed to implement health sector reforms and has proven its capacity to utilize investment and sustain the reform process, among others;

WHEREAS, the agreement covers the management and implementation of the "enhanced CIPH" CY 2014-2016, as contained in the approved CY 2014 Annual Operation Plan (AOP) of the LGU and shall focus on the achievement of improved local health system performance consistent with the internal and external benchmarks set under Article III, No. 3.1.3, table 2 of the agreement;

WHEREAS, LGU Ormoc will receive an allocation of about ONE MILLION SIX HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS (P1,650,000.00) of support from the National Government as DOH and Official Development Assistance (ODA) partner counterpart for the implementation of the enhanced CIPH through approved CY 2014 AOP, in addition to the variable allocation or performance-based entitlement in the amount of FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P500,000.00) to be released during the 3rd semester of CY2015;

MEREAS, the DOH and LGU-Ormoc mutually agreed that the Agreement herein described shall cover activities from the period January 2014 to December 2016;

WHEREAS, the concerned parties are mutually committed in collaborating for the successful and sustainable implementation of the Enhanced City Wide Investment Plan for Health II CY2014-2016 of LGU-Ormoc, subject to the specific roles and responsibilities of both parties as stipulated in the of MOA, and this Sanggunian finds, that the enhanced CIPH will help achieve the local health sector system performance and the same will indeed immensely benefit the underprivileged, and therefore, is most deserving of its prompt favorable consideration;

WHEREFORE, on joint motion of the Honorable SP Member Mario M. Rodriguez, Committee on Health and Sanitation and Honorable SP Member Benjamin S. Pongos, Jr., Chairman, Committee on Laws & Ordinances, severally seconded by City Councilors Antonio M. Codilla, Pedro Gordiardo P. Ebcas, Vincent L. Rama, Eusebio Gerardo S. Penserga, John Eulalio Nepomuceno O. Aparis II, Mariano Y. Corro and Ruben R. Capahi; be it
