RESOLUTION NO. 2016-04

A RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I GOMEZ TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT (MOPA), FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC (LGU-ORMOC), WITH THE PHILIPPINE RED CROSS (PRC), REPRESENTED BY ITS ACTING SECRETARY GENERAL, ATTY. OSCAR PALABYAB, FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF TYPHOON HAIYAN SHELTER AND WATER SANITATION AND HYGIENE (WASH) RECOVERY PROJECT IN ORMOC CITY TO BE SUPPORTED BY THE SWISS RED CROSS.

WHEREAS, this august Body was in receipt of an Indorsement from the Office of the City Mayor dated August 9, 2016, requesting therein for the passage of a resolution granting the City Mayor Richard I. Gomez, authority to enter into and sign the Memorandum of Partnership Agreement (MOPA) by and between the LGU -Ormoc and Philippine Red Cross (PRC), a photocopy of the final MOPA is hereto attached and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, PRC is an autonomous, humanitarian organization affiliated with the International Federation of the Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies, which movement is neutral and impartial, and provides protection and assistance to people affected by disasters and conflicts as well as focuses on a holistic approach to uplift the condition of the most vulnerable sectors of the society;

WHEREAS, relative thereto, PRC is providing assistance to typhoon Haiyan most affected families in six (6) Barangays in Ormoc City, particularly Barangays Manlilinao, Libertad, Dolores, Valencia, Cagbuhangin, and San Juan, including the construction of approximately Seven Hundred (700) disaster-resilient homes with comfort rooms and Seven Hundred (700) repair assistance packages, and the delivery of short-term income opportunities related to shelter repair and construction activities, which implementation thereof is the main object of this MOPA;

WHEREAS, through the support of the Swiss Red Cross, the aforementioned projects will be undertaken, and its implementation geared towards reducing the vulnerability of typhoon most affected families in the aforementioned Barancays by providing and improving their capacities in WASH and Habitability in line with the National Recovery Plan of the Philippine Government;

WHEREAS, further, the aforesaid MOPA specifies that the PRC will establish a Red Cross Barangay Recovery Committee in each of the abovementioned Barangays for the monitoring and decision-making of the project which shall be composed of focal representatives from the barangay government, different associations, as well as the affected families;

WHEREAS, the LGU-Ormoc commits itself to support regular programs of the PRC in the City as contained in the MOPA as well as offer its support to the barangay councils in all aspects, including the assignment of focal persons, for the effective and successful implementation of the said projects;

WHEREAS, the parties thereto are committed to collaborate with one another in entering into this partnership with full knowledge, commitment and willingness in the fulfillment of their responsibilities and for the effective implementation of the Typhoon Haiyan Shelter and WASH recovery projects in Ormoc City;

WHEREAS, upon close and thorough review, this Sanggunian finds that the MOPA is not contrary to law, existing contract and public morals, and that the projects are extremely beneficial to the typhoon-affected barangays in Ormoc City in its recovery and development, and so therefore, most deserving of this august Body's full support and affirmative action;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Benjamin S. Pongos Jr., Chairman, Committee on Laws and Ordinances, severally seconded by SP Members Tomas R. Serafica, Eusebio Gerardo S. Penserga, John Eulalio Nepomuceno O. Aparis II, Lea Daris C. Villar, Nolito M. Quilang and Mariano Y. Corro; be it
