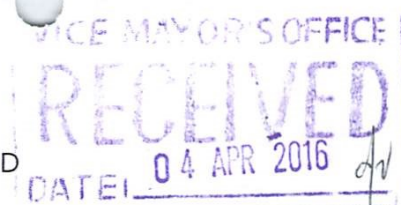

A RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE  
HONORABLE CITY MAYOR EDWARD C. CODILLA TO  
SIGN A JOINT DECLARATION OF STABLE  
INTERNAL PEACE AND SECURITY IN ORMOC CITY  
FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE LOCAL  
GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC (LGU-ORMOC)  
WITH THE 802<sup>ND</sup> INFANTRY BRIGADE, PHILIPPINE  
ARMY (PA) AND 19<sup>TH</sup> INFANTRY BATTALION,  
PHILIPPINE ARMY (PA), REPRESENTED BY COL.  
FRANCISCO F. MENDOZA, JR. AND THE ORMOC  
CITY POLICE OFFICE (OCPO), REPRESENTED BY  
CITY DIRECTOR, PSSUPT. FERDINAND M. GARAY.

WHEREAS, this august Body was in receipt of an urgent Indorsement dated March 3, 2016 from the Honorable City Mayor Edward C. Codilla, recommending for the passage of a resolution authorizing His Honor to sign a Joint Declaration of Stable Internal Peace and Security in Ormoc City for and on behalf of LGU-Ormoc with the Philippine Army 802<sup>nd</sup> Infantry Brigade and the 19<sup>th</sup> Infantry Battalion and OCPO;

WHEREAS, the Revised Joint Implementing Rules and Regulations to Executive Order No. 546 relative to Executive No. 110 prescribe the parameters and procedures in declaring priority areas as cleared from Community Terrorist Movement (CTM) influence as well as intended to respond to the dynamic nature of insurgency and determine the appropriate response in clearing priority areas;

WHEREAS, the AFP Internal Peace and Security Operation (IPSO) have launched campaign with the active support of the PNP and the LGUs to clear areas of CTM influence, neutralize the leadership of the CTM politico-military structures, insulate unaffected areas and sectoral organization from CTM infiltration and effectively deny the CTM's recovery effort in the cleared areas and coopted sectoral organizations;

WHEREAS, LGU-Ormoc has significantly contributed to the IPSO of AFP through 802<sup>nd</sup> Infantry Brigade and 19<sup>th</sup> Infantry Battalion in the clearing of Ormoc City from CTM influence by way of formulating and implementing socio-economic development programs addressing the prevailing issues exploited by the CTM which resulted to improved economic conditions and responsive delivery of basic services, together with the OCPO in the field of intelligence, civil military operations, legal offensive and tactical operations;

WHEREAS, there was an earlier recommendation from the 802<sup>nd</sup> Infantry Brigade and 19<sup>th</sup> Infantry Battalion of the Philippine Army for the declaration of Ormoc City as a City with a "Stable Internal Peace and Security" being "CLEARED" from CTM affectation and influence as shown by the decrease in CTM activities and significant improvement in peace and order situation of the city which recommendation was validated by the Joint AFP and PNP Intelligence Coordinating Council (JAPICC);

WHEREAS, the subject Joint Declaration had undergone review by the City Legal Officer who came up with a recommendation that there is no legal impediment for its execution and for this Sanggunian to pass the appropriate resolution authorizing the Honorable City Mayor to sign the same;

WHEREAS, the parties are abiding by the common bond of public service and dedication to achieve the most desired peace and order situation in the City of Ormoc, and this Sanggunian finds, after close and thorough review, that the Joint Declaration of Stable Internal Peace and Security in Ormoc City is not contrary to law and public morals, and so therefore, most deserving of this august Body's full and prompt support and favorable action;

WHEREFORE, on joint motion of the Honorable SP Member Benjamin S. Pongos Jr., Chairman, Committee on Laws and Ordinances and Honorable SP Member Vincent L. Rama, Chairman, Committee on Police, Fire and Penology, severally seconded by the Honorable SP Members Tomas R. Serafica, Antonio M. Codilla, Pedro Godiardo P. Ebcas, Eusebio Gerardo S. Penserga and John Eulalio Nepomuceno O. Aparis II; be it


