

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-059

A RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE MEMORAMOUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA), FOR AND ON BENALF OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC (LGU-ORMOC), WITH THE BUREAU OF FIRE PROTECTION (BFP) REPRESENTED BY CSUPT. RODRIGO R. ABRAZALDO FOR THE RELEASE OF THE TWENTY PERCENT (20%) LGU SHARE FROM THE FIRE CODE REVENUES.

WHEREAS, this august Body was in receipt of an Indorsement from the Office of the City Mayor dated September 13, 2016, requesting therein for the passage of a resolution granting the City Mayor Richard I. Gomez, authority to enter into and sign the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) by and between the LGU – Ormoc and BFP, a photocopy of the final MOA is hereto attached and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, the DOF-DBM-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2015-01 dated 12 February 2015, provides for the guidelines on the release of the twenty percent (20%) LGU share from the Fire Code Revenues wherein the 20% LGU share from all taxes, fees, fine collected by the BFP shall be set aside and retained for use by the city or municipal government concerned, which shall appropriate the same exclusively for the use of the operation and maintenance of its local fire station, including the construction and repair of the same;

WHEREAS, relative thereto, the BFP shall monitor the timely release of the 20% share in the fire code fees to the concerned city and ensure compliance by the city to the reportorial requirement specified herein as mandated by law, prior to the release of the succeeding funding;

WHEREAS, the LGU shall have the responsibility of ensuring that the 20% share in the fire code fees shall be for the improvement and maintenance of fire stations to include acquisition of firefighting equipment, service vehicles, investigative equipment, rescue equipment, office furniture and fixtures, and construction or repair of fire stations;

WHEREAS, both parties agree that the subject fund shall be used only on essential and necessary expenses exclusively for the maintenance of the City's BFP fire station;

WHEREAS, the parties thereto are committed in collaborating to enter into this partnership with full knowledge, commitment and willingness in the fulfillment of their responsibilities contained thereon and that are directed towards the commitment to prevent and suppress destructive fires, investigate its causes, enforce the Fire Code and other related laws, respond to man-made and natural disasters and other emergencies;

WHEREAS, upon close and thorough review, this Sanggunian, finds that the MOA is not contrary to law and existing contracts, and that its aim is extremely beneficial to ensure the effective collection of Fire Revenues and its efficient allocation for the improvement our City's BFP fire station, and so therefore, most deserving of this august Body's full support and affirmative action to the same;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Benjamin S. Pongos Jr., Chairman, Committee on Laws and Ordinances, severally seconded by SP Members Mariano Y. Corro, Lea Doris C. Villar, John Eulairo Nepomuceno O. Aparis II, Gregorio G. Yrastorza III, Eusevio Gerardo S. Penserga and Tomas R. Serafica; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass a RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA), FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC (LGU-ORMOC), WITH THE BUREAU OF FIRE PROTECTION (BFP) REPRESENTED BY CSUPT. RODRIGO R. ABRAZALDO FOR THE RELEASE OF THE TWENTY PERCENT (20%) LGU SHARE FROM THE FIRE CODE REVENUES;
