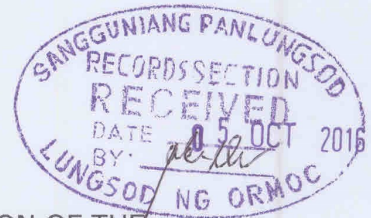

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-071

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC (LGU-ORMOC), TO ENROLL IN ELECTRONIC PAYMENT AND COLLECTION FACILITIES (EPCF) OR WEACCESS FACILITY OF THE LANDBANK OF THE PHILIPPINES (LBP) IN COMPLIANCE WITH PAG-IBIG FUND CIRCULAR NO. 365 MANDATING ALL GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE EMPLOYERS WITH AT LEAST TEN (10) EMPLOYEES TO REMIT MEMBERSHIP SAVINGS AND LOAN AMORTIZATIONS AND ALSO TO ACCOMMODATE PROCESSING AND REMITTANCES TO VARIOUS GOVERNMENT AGENCIES.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 8792 otherwise known as the "Electronic Commerce Act of 2000", emphasizes the need to create an information-friendly environment which supports and ensures the availability, diversity and affordability of Information and Communications Technology products and services;

WHEREAS, LBP's WeAccess is an internet banking facility developed for the Bank's institutional clients, both private and government entities which allows clients to make selected banking transactions online such as online settlement of government contributions or payments to the Philhealth, PAG-IBIG, SSS and BIR;

WHEREAS, with the system, filing and payment of contributions and payment of monthly loan amortizations to the selected government agencies will be faster, easier and more secured;

WHEREAS, the City Mayor Richard I. Gomez, through this Resolution, shall have authority to sign all documents necessary to subscribe to LBP's WeAccess, and designate authorized signatories to enroll and designate authorized user/s in the said facilities;

WHEREAS, in order to properly monitor the contributions/remittances, the authorized City personnel as official user/s for the account shall be covered by an office order from the responsible officer of the City;

WHEREAS, in the exercise of his authority, the City Mayor shall have the power to amend, add, delete enrolled deposit account/s as source and/or destination account/s access rights to the weAccess modules, authorization rules and/or any information on the original and succeeding enrollments;

WHEREAS, in order to avail of the said facility and system, a passage of this Resolution is deemed necessary and proper to expedite the processing of appropriate electronic transmission/s and to easily track down the history of payment, and it is the findings of this Sanggunian that said system will be beneficial to those who will avail of the same and therefore deserves to be accorded support and favorable action;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Benjamin S. Pongos Jr., Chairman, Committee on Laws and Ordinances, severally seconded by SP Members Mario M. Rodriguez, John Eulalio Nepomuceno O. Aparis II, Lea Doris C. Villar, Mariano Y. Corro and Tomas R. Serafica; be it


