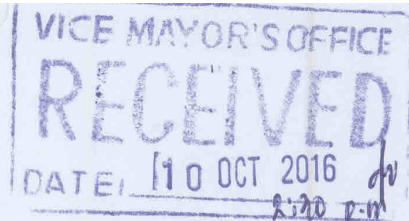
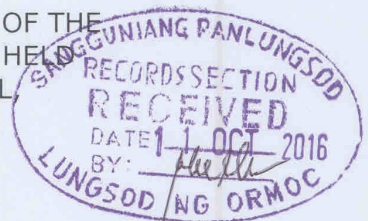

AN OMNIBUS RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FIVE (5)  
SEPARATE APPLICATIONS FOR ACCREDITATION WITH THE  
LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC, IN ACCORDANCE  
WITH THE PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE NO.009 DATED  
OCTOBER 16, 2014 OF THE FOLLOWING CIVIL SOCIETY  
ORGANIZATIONS, TO WIT:

WHEREAS, this august Body received the applications for accreditation  
with the Local Government Unit of Ormoc of the following Civil Society  
Organizations (CSOs), to wit;

1. ORMOC SOLID BRETHERN ASSOCIATION (OSBA)
2. BARANGAY DAYHAGAN SMALL FARMERS ASSOCIATION (BDaSFA)
3. BUGHO FARMERS ASSOCIATION (BFA)
4. SALVACION UNITED FARMERS ASSOCIATION (SALUFA)
5. FATIMA HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION , INC. (FHOAI)



WHEREAS, OSBA, is a DOLE registered organization which aims to develop sustainable livelihood thru the conduct of activities geared towards uplifting the economic conditions of its members. They as well provide employment opportunities to its members to help them become self-reliant;

WHEREAS, BDaSFA, is composed of farmers residing in Barangay Dayhagan Ormoc City registered under DOLE. Among its services is to give sustainable livelihood thru cassava and corn production as well as to provide its members the knowledge and skills and equip themselves with effective and innovative way of farming and livestock raising;

WHEREAS, BFA, is registered under DOLE as a non-stock, non-profit organization working for agrarian reform and rural development which utilize democratic participation in governance as one of its strategies in resolving resource tenure issues of the landless farmers;

WHEREAS, SALUFA, is an association of farmers from Brgy. Salvacion, registered with DOLE and organized themselves in order to improve their standard of living and enhance the general welfare of its members;

WHEREAS, FHOAI, is duly registered with the HLURB as homeowners association located at Brgy. Salvacion, Ormoc City. Among its purpose is to set-up a low cost Housing for the Urban Poor and further, promote, enhance and foster the development and improvement of the quality of life of the members through livelihood projects and other economic activities;

WHEREAS, the call for accreditation of CSOs was pushed by this Sanggunian in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No. 009 dated October 16, 2014 entitled: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE ACCREDITATION OF CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS (CSOs) IN THE CITY OF ORMOC" which governs the procedures for accreditation of legitimate organizations in the City of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, Section 2.1 of Ordinance No.009 provides among others that an organization may still be accredited after the prescribed sixty (60) – day period within which application for accreditation shall be accepted, for purposes other than representation to local special bodies;

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian, after thorough review of the aforementioned applications, finds that the same are in order, and the purposes of the sought accreditation are all directed to promote mutual aid, protection, and socio-economic development among its members through the establishment of a strong linkage with the LGU in order for each organization to have a better access to the diverse programs and projects of the government that are beneficial to all sectors of the community;

WHEREAS, further, this august Body deems the application to be lawful being in accordance with the provisions of the Ordinance No. 009 hence, most deserving of favorable action by this Sanggunian;

WHEREFORE, on motion of the SP Member Eusebio Gerardo S. Penserga, Chairman, Committee on Accreditation, severally seconded by the SP Members Vincent L. Rama, Tomas R. Serafica, Nolito M. Quilang, John Eulalio Nepomuceno O. Aparis II, Lea Doris C. Villar and Mariano Y. Corro; be it


