WHEREAS, Save Ormoc Bay Aggrupation, Inc., (SOBA) is a Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) registered organization which is composed of individuals from different cities and municipalities. SOBA envisions itself as a strong and effective coalition working for the protection and sustainable management of forest, coastal and marine resources, and the conservation of biodiversity as the framework for managing the cities and municipalities forest and coastal resources;

WHEREAS, Ormoc City Host Lions Club, is a civic organization which empower volunteers to serve their communities, meet humanitarian needs, encourage peace and promote international understanding. The club finds it a great privilege to be recognized and accredited by LGU-Ormoc to achieve new avenues of service and a partner in continuing its motto "To Serve";

WHEREAS, Juaton Coconut Farmers Association (JUACOFA), is a non-stock, non-profit organization registered under Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE). The association, in partnership with the City Agriculture Office, the Philippine Coconut Authority (PCA), and the Food Agriculture Organization, is working for coconut Farm Renabilitation and sustainable Agriculture thru organic Farming as one of its strategies in resolving live/ihood and climate change concerns;

WHEREAS, Ornice Rainbow Members on Credit Cooperative, is registered with Cooperative Development Authority (CDA) and organized by group of people with common interest of cooperation that is seeking for accreditation with LGU-Ormoc. As a primary credit cooperative they generate funds and extend credits to its members at minimal interest rate as well as encourage and promote self-help or self-employment as an engine for economic growth and poverty alleviation;

WHEREAS, Cebu CFI Community Cooperative-Ormoc Branch, signified its intention to have a CSO accreditation with LGU-Ormoc to advance the cooperative movement as a technique for improving the economic and social status of the people as well as to cooperate with the government and instrumentalities in the execution of government policies which will redound to the benefit of the general public. Further, the multi-purpose cooperative is registered with the Cooperative Development Authority (CDA);

WHEREAS, Lao Fisherfolks Organization (LFO), is a farmers organization in Brgy. Lao, Ormoc City and nearby areas, registered under Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) that advocates and implements responsible fishing and livelihood and related projects and programs while protecting the mangroves, coastal areas, its resources and the whole ecosystem towards sustainable development;

WHEREAS, Pura Agri Multi-Purpose Cooperative (PURAMPCO), is an organization duly registered under Cooperative Development Authority (CDA), currently seeking accreditation with LGU-Ormoc which is beneficial for the cooperative's business and socio economic relation with the LGU. Among its objectives is to provide agriculture manpower services, engage in Poultry Production, Poultry Dressing Plant, Broiler Hatchery Production, and extend credit to its members for productive and provident purposes;

WHEREAS, the call for accreditation of CSOs was pushed by this Sanggunian in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No. 009 dated October 16, 2014 entitled: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE ACCREDITATION OF CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS (CSOs) IN THE CITY OF ORMOC" which governs the procedures for accreditation of legitimate organizations in the City of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, Section 2.1 of Ordinance No.009 provides among others that an organization may still be accredited after the prescribed sixty (60) – day period within which application for accreditation shall be accepted, for purposes other than representation to local special bodies;

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian, after thorough review of the aforesaid applications, finds that the same are in order, and the purposes of the sought accreditation are all directed to promote mutual aid, protection, and socio-economic development among its members as well as to address issues on livelihood capitalization through the establishment of a strong linkage with the LGU in order for each organization to have a better access to the diverse programs and projects of the government that are beneficial to all sectors of the community.

WHEREAS, further, this august Body deems the application to be lawful being in accordance with the provisions of the Ordinance No. 003 hence, most deserving of favorable action by this Sanggunian;
