

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-110

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE LOCAL ANTI-CRIMINALITY
ACTION PLAN (LACAP) ON "ANTI-CRIMINALITY, INTERNAL
SECURITY OPERATIONS AND COUNTER-TERRORISM" FOR
THE CITY OF ORMOC.

WHEREAS, this 13th Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc was in receipt of an Endorsement dated June 14, 2016 from Honorable City Mayor Edward C. Codilla attaching thereto the Local Anti-Criminality Action Plan (LACAP) on Anti-Criminality, Internal Security Operations and Counter-Terrorism with its proposed Funding Requirements and the City Peace and Order Council (CPOC) Resolution No. 2016-02 entitled: "A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE LOCAL ANTI-CRIMINALITY ACTION PLAN (LACAP) FOR THE CITY OF ORMOC AND ENDORSING THE SAME TO THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD FOR ITS ADOPTION";

WHEREAS, this action plan envisions to strengthen and integrate the administrative and operational plans on anti-criminality aimed at attaining stable peace and order conducive for economic development;

WHEREAS, the LACAP embodies the schemes and strategies relative to the conduct of a holistic anti-crime approach to address all forms of criminality including, *inter alia*, insurgency, terrorism, illegal drugs, theft, robbery, child abuse and violence against women and children;

WHEREAS, this august Body believes that strengthening and sustaining peace and order is crucial for achieving a sustainable economic growth and development of the City, and that the same is an important factor that will increase the public's satisfaction, knowing that they can productively work, enjoy the fruits of their labor and comfortably relax at their home because of confidence that the locality is safe and secured;


