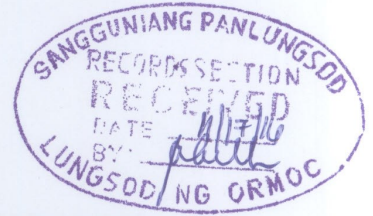

WHEREAS, this august Body received the applications for accreditation with the Local Government Unit of Ormoc of the following Civil Society Organizations (CSOs), to wit;

1. Barangay Concepcion Small Farmers Association (BACOSFA)
2. Nature Unlimited Leyte Outdoor Club (NULOC)
3. Palinpinon Farmer's Producers Cooperative
4. Pagtinabangay Foundation, Inc. (PFI)
5. Palm Village Homeowner's Association, Inc.
6. Ormoc Vendors Multi Purpose Cooperative (ORVEMPCO)
7. Sustainable Organic Farmers Association In Ormoc City (SOFAGC)
8. Exodus From Child Labor To Integration, Play, Socialization, And Education (ECLIPSE)
9. Perpetual Help Multi Purpose Cooperative (PHCCI-MPC)

WHEREAS, Barangay Concepcion Small Farmers Association (BACOSFA), is a legitimate workers association registered under Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) composed of members who are Agrarian Reform Beneficiaries. Among its objectives are to assist its members in acquiring the land awarded to them and claim support services through Agrarian Reform Programs of the government as well as security of tenure of the land they till;

WHEREAS, Nature Unlimited Leyte Outdoor Club (NULOC), is a registered mountaineering club in Ormoc City, under Mountaineering Federation of the Philippines, Incorporated (MFPI) and with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC). The club and its members support the government's advocacy in nature and environment preservation and rehabilitation, government community developmental programs and other events, such as beachurero-the club's yearly event every September in support of the Ocean Conservatory;

WHEREAS, Palinpinon Farmer's Producers Cooperative, is organized by a group of farmers from Barangay Margen, this City and registered with the Cooperative Development Authority (CDA). Their primary consideration is to undertake agricultural and livestock production and also to adopt and implement plans and programs which ensures the continued build-up of the cooperative's capital structure with the end view of establishing other needed services for the members and the public;

WHEREAS, Pagtinabangay Foundation, Inc. (PFI), is a non-profit and non-stock corporation duly registered under Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) which envisioned a poverty-free countryside. The foundation does community organizing work, trainings and workshops on natural farming system, local governance, advocacy activities, health programs and they also work against all forms of social inequities;

WHEREAS, Palm Village Homeowner's Association, Inc., is duly registered under the Housing and Land Use Regulatory Board (HLURB) as homeowners association located at Brgy. Linao, Ormoc City. Its primary concern is to facilitate the delivery of adequate social services and economic advantages for the association to improve the quality of life and well-being of its members;

WHEREAS, Ormoc Vendors Multi Purpose Cooperative (ORVEMPCO), is a primary multi-purpose cooperative presently seeking accreditation with LGU-Ormoc and duly registered under Cooperative Development Authority (CDA). Its main objective is to help improve the quality of life of its members and further aims to actively support the government, other cooperatives and people oriented organizations, both local and foreign, in promoting cooperatives as a practical means towards sustainable socio-economic development under a truly just and democratic society;

WHEREAS, Sustainable Organic Farmers Association in Ormoc City (SOFAOC), is an organization of farmers in Brgy. San Pablo engage in planting various commodities from crops to vegetables as well as raising of livestock and small ruminants. The association is instrumental of conveying systematic and innovative technologies on organic farming strategies. Further, they are registered under Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE);

WHEREAS, Exodus from Child Labor to Integration, Play, Socialization, and Education (ECLIPSE), is a non government organization registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC). ECLIPSE is committed to serve the children, and in particular the working children – to facilitate their exodus from child labor and exploitation to the fullest possible enjoyment of their rights, to the vast sea of opportunities for their physical, intellectual, emotional, social, moral and spiritual development;

WHEREAS, Perpetual Help Multi Purpose Cooperative (PHCCI-MPC), is a cooperative duly registered with the Cooperative Development Authority and seeking for accreditation with LGU-Ormoc. Among its objectives is to extend credit to its members for productive and provident purposes at reasonable rate of interests as well as to establish other loan facility responsive to their needs;

WHEREAS, the call for accreditation of CSOs was pushed by this Sanggunian in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No. 009 dated October 16, 2014 entitled: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE ACCREDITATION OF CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS (CSOs) IN THE CITY OF ORMOC" which governs the procedures for accreditation of legitimate organizations in the City of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, Section 2.1 of Ordinance No. 009 provides among others that an organization may still be accredited after the prescribed sixty (60) – day period within which application for accreditation shall be accepted, for purposes other than representation to local special bodies;

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian, after thorough review of the aforesaid applications, finds that the same are in order, and the purposes of the sought accreditation are all directed to promote mutual aid, protection, and socio-economic development among its members as well as to address issues on livelihood capitalization through the establishment of a strong linkage with the LGU in order for each organization to have a better access to the diverse programs and projects of the government that are beneficial to all sectors of the community;

WHEREAS, further, this august Body deems the application to be lawful being in accordance with the provisions of the Ordinance No. 009 hence, most deserving of favorable action by this Sanggunian;
