A RESOLUTION RATIFYING AND CONFIRMING THE
AUTHORITY GRANTED TO ORMOC CITY MAYOR RICHARD I.
GOMEZ TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF
AGREEMENT (MOA) FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE LOCAL
GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC (LGU ORMOC) WITH THE
LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACADEMY (LGA), DEPARTMENT OF
INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (DILG RO8) AND THE
LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF QUEZON CITY FOR THE
PURPOSE OF FORGING STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIPS
PURSUANT TO THE INNOVATIVE SOLUTIONS BANK ON
LOCAL GOVERNANCE (ISBLG) PROGRAM AS PER SP
RESOLUTION NO. 2016-108.

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian passed SP Resolution No. 2016-108 which
granted authority to Ormoc City Mayor Richard I. Gomez to enter into a partnership
agreement for and on behalf of the Local Government Unit of Ormoc (LGU Ormoc)
for the enrollment of LGU Ormoc under the Innovative Solutions Bank on Local
Governance Program (ISBLG);

WHEREAS, "Mamayang Ayaw Sa Anomalya, Mamamayang Ayaw Sa Iligal Na
Droga" (MASA MASID) is a barangay-based anti-criminality, anti-corruption, and
anti-illegal drugs program implemented by the DILG which encourages multi-
sectoral partnership to intensify the spirit of volunteerism at the community level;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Quezon City has come up with a very good anti-drug campaign program which basically involves a community-based rehabilitation approach designed as a holistic intervention for recovering dependents with focus on their physical and psycho-social healing, as well as, the involvement of the support of families and the community and is among the featured replicable best practices in the ISBLG;

WHEREAS, cognizant of the prevalent drug problems, the Local Government Unit of Ormoc recognizes the significance of using innovative practices to heighten community involvement by mobilizing the support of local stakeholders, volunteers, civic organizations, faith-based organizations, and the private sectors in the fight against illegal drugs, criminality and corruption;

WHEREAS, the parties thereto are committed in collaborating to enter into this partnership with full knowledge, commitment and willingness in the fulfillment of their responsibilities contained thereon and that are directed towards forging strategic partnerships in pursuing their common goals;

WHEREAS, upon close and thorough review, this Sanggunian, finds that the MOA is not contrary to law and existing contracts and that the ISBLG Program is deemed helpful to LGU Ormoc's quest for a more innovative approach to repress corruption, illegal drugs and criminality problems in its localities and so therefore, most deserving of this august Body's full support and affirmative action to the same;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Benjamin S. Pongos Jr., Chairman, Committee on Laws and Ordinances, severally seconded by SP Members Vincent L. Rama, Tomas R. Serafica and Mariano Y. Corro; be it


RESOLVED, FURTHER, that a copy of the final and notarized Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) be furnished to this Sanggunian for its information and files;
