 SEPARATE APPLICATIONS FOR ACCREDITATION WITH THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC, IN CCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE NO.009 DATED OCTOBER 16, 2014 OF THE FOLLOWING CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS, TO WIT:
 - 1 UNITED ALBUERA ORMOC MULTICAB OPERATORS AND DRIVERS ASSOCIATION (UAOMODA)
 - 2. UNITED FARMERS ASSOCIATION OF BAGONG (UFAB)
 - AND FLOWERS MULTI-PURPOSE 3. ORMOC PLANTS COOPERATIVE
 - 4. R.M. TAN UNITED FARMERS ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS, this august Body received the applications for accreditation with the Local Government Unit of Ormoc of the following Civil Society Organizations (CSOs), to wit;

- 1. United Albuera Ormoc Multicab Operators and Drivers Association (UAOMODA)
- 2. United Farmers Association of Bagong (UFAB)

- 3. Ormoc Plants and Flowers Multi-Purpose Cooperative
- 4. R.M. Tan United Farmers Association

WHEREAS, United Albuera – Ormoc Multicab Operators and Drivers Association (UAOMODA), organized themselves into an association in order to improve their standard of living and for mutual aid and protection of its members thereby enhance their general welfare. The association is duly registered by the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) along with its purpose to provide the members knowledge and skills and equip themselves with effective and innovative ways to further develop their occupation;

WHEREAS, United Farmers Association of Bagong (UFAB), is composed of farmers from Brgy. Bagong, Ormoc City, registered with Department of Labor and Employment. UFAB is organized to manage the development of the livelihood of its members in their community and promote the group's capabilities to improve their lives through hard work, commitment, and faith;

WHEREAS, Ormoc Plants and Flowers Multi-Purpose Cooperative, is duty registered with the Cooperative Development Authority (CDA) and expresses its interest and willingness to apply for accreditation to LGU-Ormoc. Among its purposes are to engage in lending activities, buy and sell and production of cut flowers and plants, and accept plants and flowers decoration for all occasions as well as to generate funds and extend credit to its members for productive and provident purposes;

WHEREAS, R.M. Tan United Farmers Association, is a registered farmers association under the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE), residing in Brgy. R.M. Tan Ormoc City. Among the association's objectives is to extend support to their farmer beneficiaries in order to have good harvest and be able to increase their income to become more progressive and productive farmers;

WHEREAS, the call for accreditation of CSOs was pushed by this Sanggunian in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No. 009 dated October 16, 2014 entitled: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE ACCREDITATION OF CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS (CSOs) IN THE CITY OF ORMOC" which governs the procedures for accreditation of legitimate organizations in the City of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, Section 2.1 of Ordinance No.009 provides among others that an organization may still be accredited after the prescribed sixty (60) – day period within which application for accreditation shall be accepted, for purposes other than representation to local special bodies;

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian, after thorough review of the aforementioned applications, finds that the same are in order, and the purposes of the sought accreditation are all directed to promote mutual aid, protection, and socio-economic development among its members as well as to address issues on livelihood capitalization through the establishment of a strong linkage with the LGU in order for each organization to have a better access to the diverse programs and projects of the government that are beneficial to all sectors of the community;

WHEREAS, further, this august Body deems the application to be lawful being in accordance with the provisions of the Ordinance No. 009 hence, most deserving of favorable action by this Sanggunian;
