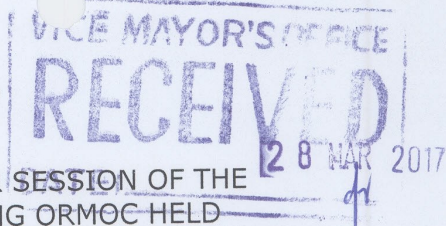

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-056

A RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO ORMOC CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC (LGU-ORMOC), WITH THE VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY (VSU) REPRESENTED BY ITS UNIVERSITY PRESIDENT, DR. EDGARDO E. TULIN, AND THE LIGA NG MGA BARANGAY-ORMOC CITY CHAPTER, REPRESENTED BY ITS LIGA CHAPTER PRESIDENT, ATTY. MARIANO Y. CORRO FOR AN INTEGRATED EFFORT TO ACHIEVE EFFICIENT AND EFFECTIVE GOVERNANCE THROUGH THE USE OF THE BARANGAY INTEGRATED DEVELOPMENT APPROACH FOR NUTRITION IMPROVEMENT (BIDANI) STRATEGY.

WHEREAS, the City Mayor Richard I. Gomez through an Indorsement dated December 2, 2016 had forwarded to this august Body for consideration the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to be entered into by LGU-Ormoc with the Visayas State University (VSU) and the Liga ng mga Barangay- Ormoc City Chapter and further requesting for authority to sign the same, a copy of the MOA is hereto attached and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, the object of the MOA is mainly to empower and enhance LGU-Ormoc's capacity to achieve efficient and effective governance through an integrated effort in partnership with concerned government and non-government agencies through the use of the BIDANI Strategy;



WHEREAS, BIDANI is a collaborative extension and action research program of higher education as well as private and public institutions initiated and institutionalized by the State Universities and Colleges (SUCs) and introduced to the LGUs as a development strategy in local governance useful in program planning and management of Programs, Projects and Activities (PPAs), with the Visayas State University (VSU) as one of the Seven (7) original key regional member satellite SUCs of the BIDANI Network program in the country;

WHEREAS, BIDANI is found to be supportive and consistent with the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991, specifically Section 16-17 thereof, which mandates LGUs to promote the general welfare and provide an effective and efficient basic social services and facilities; the Philippine Plan of Action for Nutrition (PPAN); the Localization of the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs); and the Local Governance Performance Management System (LGPMS);

WHEREAS, to note, the BIDANI program was already adopted and used by the different barangays in Ormoc City since CY 2012 and was found to be an effective tool in ascertaining the needs and interests of the communities and as a means of bringing a clear picture of such identified needs and interests of the people to the concerned legislative bodies for appropriate local legislation. Hence, the Liga ng mga Barangay- Ormoc City Chapter desires for the continuous operationalization of the BIDANI Strategy in the 110 barangays in Ormoc City to move forward the development of each barangay as manifested through Liga ng mga Barangay Resolution No. 2014-32;

WHEREAS, this august Body, mindful of the importance and advantages of using the BIDANI program as a development strategy and a delivery mechanism to accelerate rural and urban development by enhancing the LGU capabilities in development planning and effective management of its PPAs, fully supports the proposed collaboration of efforts by and between LGU-Ormoc, the Liga ng mga Barangay-Ormoc City Chapter, and VSU, through the execution of this MOA, subject to the stipulations and fulfillment of the specific obligations of each of the concerned parties involved;

WHEREFORE, on joint motion of SP Member Mario M. Rodriguez, Chairman, Committee on Health and Sanitation and SP Member Benjamin S. Pongos, Jr. Chairman, Committee Laws and Ordinances, jointly seconded by SP Members Nolito M. Quilang and Mariano Y. Corro; be it
