

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-065

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE TEN (10) YEAR ORMOC CITY LOCAL CLIMATE CHANGE ACTION PLAN (LCCAP) FOR CALENDAR YEARS 2016 - 2025.

WHEREAS, Sections 2a; 15; and 3i of the Local Government Code (RA 7160) mandates every Local Government Unit (LGU), as a political unit, to exercise their inherent powers, as well as share with the national government the responsibility in the management and maintenance of ecological balance in their respective territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS. Section 11, Par. 2 of the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010 (RA 10121) states that, Local Government Units (LGUs) shall ensure the integration of disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation into local development plans, programs and budgets as a strategy in sustainable development and poverty reduction;

WHEREAS, Section 14 of the Climate Change Act of 2009 (RA 9729), as amended by RA 10174, provides that, Local Government Units (LGUs) shall be the frontline agencies in the formulation, planning and implementation of climate change action plans in their respective areas consistent with the provisions of the Local Government Code (LGC), the National Framework Strategy on Climate Change (NFSCC), and the National Climate Change Action Plan (NCCAP);

WHEREAS, Section 1 of the Climate Change Act of 2009 (RA 9729), as amended by RA 10174, recognized the need to ensure that national and subnational government policies, plans, programs and projects are funded upon sound environmental considerations and the principle of sustainable development, to systematically integrate the concept of climate change in various phases of policy formulation, development plans, poverty reduction strategies and other development tools and techniques by all agencies and instrumentalities of the government;

WHEREAS, in line with the local government's initiative to address risks to hazard (notably natural hazards which is greatly affected by changing climatic condition), the Local Climate Change Action Plan contains measures that a local government unit must undertake and mainstreamed to be able to adopt to climate change, to mitigate its effects, and to maximize its benefits;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 42 (as amended) created the Ormoc City Local Climate Change Action Plan – Core Team and the LCCAP Technical Working Group (TWG) to oversee the crafting and formulation of the City Local Climate Change Action Plan consistent with the mandate of Republic Act 9729 (Philippine Climate Change Act of 2009);

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Ormoc City with the technical assistance from the United States Agency for International Aid (USAID) – Be Secure Project, has crafted a Ten (10)-Year Local Climate Change Action Plan (LCCAP) for the City of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, the City Development Council (CDC) during its full Council Meeting on February 27, 2017, unanimously approved to adopt the Local Climate Change Action Plan (LCCAP) as presented, as it is deemed necessary and in accordance to the need of the City;

WHEREAS, on motion of SP Member Tomas Serafica, seconded by SP Member Mario M. Rodriguez, the Ten (10)-Year Ormoc City Local Climate Change Action Plan (LCCAP) for Calendar Year 2016-2025 was approved and adopted at the Committee Level by the Committee on Environment and Natural Resources last March 27, 2017;

WHEREFORE, upon motion of SP Member Gregorie G. Yrastorza, III, Chairman, Committee on Environment & Natural Resources, severally seconded by SP Members Mario M. Rodriguez, Tomas R. Serafica, Benjamin S. Pongos, Jr., Eusebio Gerardo S. Penserga, Nolito M. Quilang, John Eulalio Nepomuceno O. Aparis II, Lea Doris C. Villar and Mariano Y. Corro; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass a RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE TEN (10)-YEAR ORMOC CITY LOCAL CLIMATE CHANGE ACTION PLAN (LCCAP) FOR CALENDAR YEARS 2015 - 2025.

ADOPTED, March 30, 2017.
