## RESOLUTION NO. 2017-111

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF ORMOT, THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE ORMOC FESTIVAL AND CULTURAL FOUNDATION, INC., REPRESENTED BY ESTRELLA MARIA S. PANGILINAN FOR THE **PURPOSE** IMPLEMENTING THE CULTURAL MAPPING PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Sanggunian was in receipt of an endorsement from the office of the City Mayor requesting the august body to give City Mayor Richard I. Gomez an authority to enter into and sign a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) on behalf of the City of Ormoc with Ormoc Festival and Cultural Foundation, Inc., represented by Estrella Maria S. Pangilinan;

WHEREAS, Section 15 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution states that "x x x The State shall conserve, promote, and popularize the nation's historical and cultural heritage and resources, x x x.";

WHEREAS, with the abundance of natural, historical and cultural heritages of the City of Ormoc, there is a need to create a broad awareness campaign for the heritage to be valued, owned and used by the people so that the benefits of tourism and industries would redound to the betterment of the community;

WHEREAS, Cultural Mapping is a heritage conservation approach where cultural heritage resources are identified and documented in a specific locality for purposes of meaningful development;

WHEREAS, a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) is needed in order to define and specify roles and obligations of the parties in the project implementation and to ensure the commitments to deliver the outputs of the projects;

WHEREAS, upon thorough discussion and examination, the two committees concerned find the grant of authority to the City Mayor to enter into and sign the Memorandum of Agreement proper and not contrary to existing laws, morals and public order;

WHEREAS, on motion of SP Member Penserga, seconded by SP Members Villar, Aparis and Rodriguez, the MOA as amended was approved at the committee level;

Rodriguez, Tomas R. Serafica, Eusebio Gerardo S. Penserga John Eulalio Nepomuceno O. Aparis II, Lea Doris C. Villar and Mariano Y. Corro; be it

PANGILINAN FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPLEMENTING THE CULTURAL MAPPING PROJECT;
