## RESOLUTION NO. 2017-136

A RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA), FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC (LGU-ORMOC) WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT RESOURCES NATURAL THE THROUGH ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT BUREAU-REGION (DENR, EMB-8) FOR THE GRANTING OF A SUPPORT FUND AMOUNTING TO ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY THOUSAND PESOS (PhP180,000.00) UNDER THE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PROGRAM, FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT (SWM) IN THE PUBLIC MARKET OF ORMOC CITY.

of the City Mayor dated June 13, 2017, requesting therein for the passage of a resolution granting the City Mayor Richard I. Gomez, authority to enter into and sign the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA), for and on behalf of the Local Government Unit of Ormoc (SECOND PARTY), with the Department of Environment and Natural Resources through the Environmental Management Bureau – Region VIII (FIRST PARTY) for the granting of a support fund amounting to One Hundred Eighty Thousand Pesos (PhP 180,000.00) under the Solid Waste Management Program, for the implementation of solid waste management in the public market of Ormoc City, a photocopy of the final Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) is hereto attached and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, Section 10 of Republic Act No. 9003, known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 states that pursuant to the relevant provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991 (RA 7160) local government units are primarily responsible for the implementation and enforcement of the provisions of RA 9003;

WHEREAS, the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 (RA 9003), provides for the Ecological Solid Waste Management System, creating the necessary institutional mechanisms and incentives, and appropriating funds therefor to guide local government units (LGUs) in the achievement for the objectives of the Act;

WHEREAS, Section 20 of RA 9003 requires Local Government Units (LGUs) to divert solid waste from waste disposal facilities through re-use, recycling, composting, and other resource recovery activities;

WHEREAS, through the Waste Analysis and Characterization Study (WACS) conducted in the cities and municipalities within the Region, biodegradable wastes constitute the bulk of wastes generation and these come from public markets

WHEREAS, Section 8 of the same Act, mentions the role of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) to provide the technical and other capability building assistance and support to the Local Government Units (LGUs) in the development and implementation of local solid waste management plans and programs;

WHEREAS, in order for the Local Government Units (LGUs) to fulfill one of their responsibilities to divert solid waste from going into disposal facilities, the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) through the Environmental Management Bureau – Region VIII (EMB-VIII) launches the establishment and institutionalization of Solid Waste Management System at the 1993 Public Market;

WHEREAS, upon close and thorough review, this Sanggunian finds that the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) is not contrary to law, public policy, public morals and existing contracts, and that the aim of this project is highly noble in that together the City and the DENR EMB-8 will be undertaking a program that will greatly benefit the inhabitants of the City and its environment, so therefore, most deserving of this august Body's full support and affirmative action;

WHEREFORE, on notion of SP Member Gregorio G. Yrastorza III, Chairman, Committee on Environment and Natural Resources, severally seconded by SP Members Vincent L. Rarna, Mario M. Rodriguez, Eusebio Gerardo S. Penserga, John Eulalio Nepomuceno D. Aparis II, Lea Doris C. Villar and Mariano Y. Corro; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass a RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I.
