## RESOLUTION NO. 2017-145

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPLICATIONS FOR ACCREDITATION WITH THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 009 DATED OCTOBER 16, 2014 OF THE FOLLOWING CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS, TO WIT:

GUINNIGUI-AN CHRISTIAN CHURCH ADELFA SMALL FARMER'S ASSOCIATION (GCC-ASFA).

2. ALPABETO LIVELIHOOD ASSOCIATION (ALA) INC.

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian received the applications of GUINTIGUI-AN CHRISTIAN CHURCH ADELFA SMALL FARMERS ASSOCIATION (GCC-ASFA) and ALRABETO LIVELIHOOD ASSOCIATION (ALA) INC., both Civil Society Organizations (CSOs), seeking for accreditation with the Local Government Unit of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, GUINTIGUI-AN CHRISTIAN CHURCH ADELFA SMALL FARMERS ASSOCIATION (GCC-ASFA), is a group of farmers from Purok Adelfa, Barangay Guintigui-an, Ormoc City and registered with the Department of Labor and Employment. Among the association's purpose is to develop a sustainable livelihood for its members through the availment of viable grants or aid from the Department of Agriculture in terms of Livestock program and other programs that will upgrade the farming system in their area;

WHEREAS, ALPABETO LIVELIHOOD ASSOCIATION (ALA) INC., is a non-stock and non-profit association composed of farmers from different Barangays, this City, registered under Securities and Exchange Commission. Among its purpose is to become a partner of government in community development and to unite the members into one solid livelihood organization for the general welfare of its members;

WHEREAS, it can be recalled that this Sanggunian has enacted Ordinance No. 009 dated October 16, 2014 entitled: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE ACCREDITATION OF CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS (CSOs) IN THE CITY OF ORMOC" which governs the procedures for accreditation of legitimate organizations in the City of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, Section 2.1 of Ordinance No. 009 provides among others that an organization may still be accredited after the prescribed sixty (60) – day period within which application for accreditation shall be accepted, for purposes other than representation to local special bodies;

WHEREAS, after close and thorough review of the aforementioned applications, this Sanggunian finds that the same are in order, and the purposes of the sought accreditation are all directed to promote mutual aid, protection, and socio-economic development among its members as well as to establish a strong linkage with the LGU and actively participate in the implementation of the diverse programs and projects of the government to promote inclusive growth.

WHEREAS, further, this august Body deem the applications to be lawful being in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No. 109 hence, most deserving of favorable action by this Sanggunian;
