RESOLUTION NO. 2017-147

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION OF AN EVACUATION CENTER IN A PORTYON OF THE CITY-OWNED PROPERTY DESCRIBED AS IN BARANGAY MACABUG, ORMOC CITY.

HEREAS, this Sanggunian was in receipt of a communication from the Office of the City Mayor Richard I. Gomez dated June 13, 2017 endorsing the lassification of Lot 1-C in Barangay Macabug, Ormoc City as an evacuation center and further requesting the passage of a resolution enabling and empowering the City to coordinate with other offices and/or agencies for the funding of the said vacuation center;

WHEREAS, it has been a national policy under Section 2(a) of Republic Act 10121, otherwise known as the "Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Makagement Act of 2010", to uphold the people's constitutional rights to life and property by addressing the root causes of vulnerabilities to disasters, strengthening the country's institutional capacity for disaster risk reduction and management, and building the resilience of local communities to disasters including climate change impacts;

WHEREAS, Local Government Units (LGUs) are authorized under Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, which is generally referred to as the General Welfare Clause, to "xxx exercise the powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare";

WHEREAS, the LGU-Ormoc, considering that it is located in a calamity-prone region of the country, is highly concerned and committed at protecting the lives of its residents at all times and at mitigating the effects of man-made and natural disasters;

WHEREAS, through a certification issued by Engr. Raoul E. Cam, City Planning and Development Coordinator, a parcel of land designated as Lot 1-C, situated in Barangay Macabug, Ormoc City, containing an area of ten thousand (10,000) square meters more or less, which is owned by the City Government of Ormoc falls within the areas classified as Barangay Built-Up Area (BBA) and therefore, is suitable for the intended construction of an evacuation center;

WHEREAS, although in the past schools, covered courts and even churches have been used as evacuation centers by the City, however, the same are not structurally designed to withstand man-made disaster or natural calamities, do not have enough water supply, proper ventilation, toilet and lighting and therefore are not adequately built and equipped to cater to the demands of a formal evacuation center;

WHEREAS, providing evacuation centers is the response of the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) to the increasing need for improving the resiliency and preparedness of the country in terms of disaster response, and that the protection and comfort that it will provide has an impact to those who will be utilizing these centers in times of enormous disasters:

WHEREAS, the DPWH Fourth District Engineering Office of Dayte had manifested willingness to construct buildings and structures on the said City-owned property for use as evacuation center by the City and for said undertaking, a Sanggunian resolution approving the same is a requirement by the said Office;

WHEREAS, upon presentation by the DPWH of the plans and designs of the proposed evacuation center, it was discovered that only a substantial portion of the total land area of the said City-owned property will be utilized for the said evacuation center:

WHEREAS, this Sangeunian finds that the aforementioned lot indeed is suitable for the intended evacuation center to be constructed by the DPWH, and that the aforementioned request by the City Mayor is advantageous and for the best interest of the City and its inhabitants as an evacuation center is an essential component of the City's disaster or emergency response capability;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Benjamin S. Pongos, Jr., Chairman, Committee on Public Properties, severally seconded by the SP Members Tomas R. Serafica, Eusebio Gerardo S. Penserga, Gregorio G. Yrastorza III, John Eulalio Nepomuceno O. Aparis II, Lea Doris V. Villar and Mariano Y. Corro; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass a RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION OF AN EVACUATION CENTER IN A PORTION OF THE CITY-OWNED PROPERTY DESCRIBED AS LOT 1-C IN BARANGAY MACABUG, ORMOC CITY;
