WHEREAS, for consideration by this august Body is an urgent Indorsement dated June 22, 2017 from the Office of the City Mayor requesting authority from this Sanggunian for the City Mayor Richard I. Gomez to enter into and sign for and on behalf of LGU-Ormoc, a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Partner Schools of the Ormoc City Scholarship Program, a copy of which is hereto attached and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, the MOA is a vital component in the implementation of the "Ormoc City Scholarship Program Ordinance" (Ord. No. 028, Series of 2017) enacted by this Sanggunian in furtherance of one of the City's priority thrusts which is to put premium on education through among others the setting up of a scholarship program accessible by the underprivileged but deserving Ormocanon youths;

WHEREAS, the agreement lay down the obligations of both parties in terms of providing assistance to the city scholars in complying both the schools' academic requirements and the City Scholarship Program requirements during the entire scholarship period;
