WHEREAS, Matica-a Organic Farmers Association (MOFA), is a legitimate farmers' association from Brgy. Matica-a, Ormoc City, duly registered under Department of Labor and Employment. Among its objective is to establish an association that will promote mutual aid and protection to its members as well as equip themselves with effective and innovative ways of organic agriculture production and marketing;

WHEREAS, Margen, San Juan Small Farmers Association (MARSFA), is also an association registered with the Department of Labor and Employment presently composed of Sixty-Four (64) members who are community based agrarian reform beneficiaries (ARB's) small farmers, aimed to protect and promote the rights and interests of the women, children's, farmers and fisher folks and uplift their living conditions through organized and concerted actions. The organization recognizes the importance of democratic participation in local decision making and in governance;

WHEREAS, San Jose Sabang Bao Farmer-Irrigators Multi-Purpose Cooperative (SJSB FIMPCO), is a group of farmers willing to get involved in the plans and programs in the Local Government Unit of Ormoc. SJSB FIMPCO is registered under the Cooperative Development Authority (CDA) which officers and members had undergone different trainings and seminars facilitated by CDA. Among its purpose is to undertake lending operation, maintenance of access and farm level irrigation and drainage facilities, as well as engage in management of support services for irrigated agriculture.

WHEREAS, Salvacion Go Nomeowners Association, Inc. (SGHOAI), is a non-profit, non-stock association composed of residents from Brgy. Bantigue and registered under the Housing and Land Use Regulatory Board (HLURB). Its primary concern is to facilitate the delivery of adequate social services and economic advantages for the association to improve the quality of life and well-being of its members;

WHEREAS, the call for accreditation of CSOs was pushed by this Sanggunian in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No. 009 dated October 16, 2014 entitled: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE ACCREDITATION OF CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS (CSOs) IN THE CITY OF ORMOC" which provides for the procedures for accreditation of legitimate organizations in the City of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, Section 2.1 of Ordinance No. 009 provides among others that an organization may still be accredited after the prescribed sixty (60) – day period within which application for accreditation shall be accepted, for purposes other than representation to local special bodies;

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian, after thorough review of the aforementioned applications, find that the same are in order, and the purposes of the sought accreditation are all directed to promote mutual aid, protection, and socio-economic development among its members as well as to address issues on livelihood capitalization through the establishment of a strong linkage with the LGU in order for each organization to have a better access to the diverse programs and projects of the government that are beneficial to all sectors of the community;
