WHEREAS, eight members of the Ormoc City Kingfisher Swimmming Team, competed in the Batang Pinoy 2017 Visayas Qualifying Games on November 10-16, 2017 at Dumaquete City;

WHEREAS, in the said competition organized by the Philippine Sports Competition, a total of 42 Cities and Municipalities sent official delegates to represent their respective local government units in the various swimming events;

WHEREAS, the official 9-man swimming delegation of Ormoc City garnered eight (8) golds, four (4) silvers and six (6) bronzes during the said competition ranking the team in the top three (3);

WHEREAS, due to said feat, the top 5 swimmers for each category, has qualified the young Ormocanons to slots in the National Championships in the next year 2018;

WHEREAS, representing the Philippines, swimmer Martine Anela Estrella, for the 9-10 category, won 1 gold in the 200m freestyle relay and a total of 4 bronzes for the 50m fly, 100m fly, 50m backstroke and 200 individual medley;

WHEREAS, another Ormocanon also representing the Philippines, Chloe Sophia Laurente, won 1 gold in the 200 individual medley, 1 gold in the 200m freestyle relay, 1 bronze in the 100m backstroke and 1 bronze in the 100m fly in the 11-12 category;

WHEREAS, the two swimmers who competed in Japan were selected by the Philippine Swimming League (PSL) as recognized by the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC), as accredited by the Federation of School Sports Association of the Philippines (FESSAP) and an internationally affiliated member of the Federation of International Sports University (FISU),

WHEREAS, this august Body and its Members, with the boundless support the City Mayor Richard I. Gomez, highly recognize and value the leaps of achievements and accolades the swimmers, in particular, and the Ormoc City Kingfisher Swimming Team, in general, has brought to the City;

WHEREAS, this Body reciprocates the team's achievements with this recognition and an incentive of five thousand pesos (P5, 000.00) for each of the medalist and five thousand pesos (P5, 000.00) also for the coach of the team;
