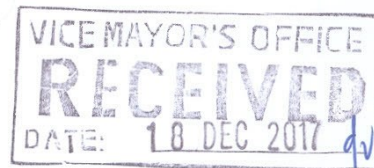

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-286

*A RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO ORMOC CITY  
MAYOR RICHARD J. GOMEZ TO ACCESS AND UTILIZE THE  
CITY'S UNEXPENDED BALANCES OF THE LOCAL DISASTER  
RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT FUND (LDRRMF).*

WHEREAS, the City of Ormoc is greatly affected by TROPICAL DEPRESSION  
URDUJA;

WHEREAS, as per verification, assessment and certification by the City  
Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (CDRRMC), the following are the  
ongoing adverse effects of Tropical Depression Urduja;

1. There is extensive flooding in nineteen (19) identifiable barangays;
2. Landslides in several upland barangays;
3. At least 1,929 families have been evacuated, as of 5 o'clock in the afternoon of December 16, 2017;
4. At least 76,000 individuals are affected, as of 5 o'clock in the afternoon of December 16, 2017;
5. Damage to bridges and infrastructure;
6. Extensive damage to agriculture, of at least 40% of agricultural crops, as of 5 o'clock in the afternoon of December 16, 2017
7. Interruption in water services;
8. Power outages;

WHEREAS, the CDRRMO has issued a "RESOLUTION TO RECOMMEND THE  
DECLARATION OF A STATE OF CALAMITY OF THE CITY OF ORMOC PURSUANT TO  
THE PROVISIONS OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10121, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE  
"PHILIPPINE DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT ACT OF 2010" dated  
December 16, 2017;

WHEREAS, an Endorsement dated Dec 16, 2017, from the Office of the City Mayor was submitted to this Sanggunian requesting for appropriate action on the said resolution from the CDRRMC and further requesting that the matter be treated as urgent;

WHEREAS, this august Body finds the said Endorsement by the City Mayor to be meritorious and deserving of this Sanggunian's prompt and full support for the extreme benefit and welfare it would redound to the City, especially in terms of its relief, rehabilitation and repair efforts for the affected families and damages to agriculture and other properties;

WHEREFORE, FOREGOING PREMISES CONSIDERED, on motion of SP Member Mario M. Rodriguez, Chairman, Committee on Finance & Appropriation, severally seconded by SP Members Vincent L. Rama, Rolando M. Vilasencio, Tomas R. Serafica, Benjamin S. Pongos, Jr., Mariano Y. Corro, Lea Doris C. Villar, John Eulalio Nepomuceno O. Aparis II, Nolito M. Quilang, Gregorio G. Yrastorza III and Eusebio Gerardo S. Penserga; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass A RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO ORMOC CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ TO ACCESS AND UTILIZE THE CITY'S UNEXPENDED BALANCES OF THE LOCAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT FUND (LDRRMF);

ADOPTED, December 16, 2017.
