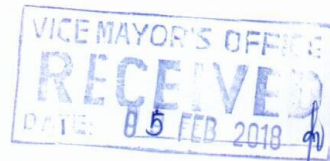

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-022

A RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ OR THE ACTING CITY MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC (LGU-ORMOC), THROUGH THE CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT, WITH SAN LORENZO RUIZ COLLEGE OF ORMOC, INC. (SLRC) FOR THE RENEWAL OF AFFILIATION WITH THE LGU HEALTH CENTERS AND CLINICAL LABORATORY AS TRAINING LABORATORIES FOR SLRC MEDICAL TECHNOLOGY INTERNS.

WHEREAS, an Indorsement was forwarded to this august Body from the Office of the City Mayor dated January 23, 2018, endorsing the recommendation of Atty. Jesus Manuel A. Horca, III, Assistant City Legal Officer, for the issuance of a Resolution granting the City Mayor the authority to sign the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the Local Government Unit of Ormoc (LGU Ormoc) and San Lorenzo Ruiz College of Ormoc, Inc. (SLRC) for the latter's renewal of affiliation with the LGU Health Centers and Clinical Laboratory and further classifying the same as URGENT, a photocopy of the said MOA is hereto attached as Annex "A" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, the provisions of DOH Administrative Order No. 9-C, series of 1997, implementing Administrative Order No. 5, series of 1996 provides for the rules and regulations which govern the affiliation and training of students in government hospitals and other health facilities;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 455, Paragraph (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, which authorizes the City Mayor to represent the city in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod concerned pursuant to law or ordinance;

WHEREAS, there is a need to expose Medical Technology students in the promotion, maintenance and delivery of health related services inasmuch as our health offices are directly engaged in rendering health related services to the community;

WHEREAS, this renewal will continue to promote cooperation and rapport between the two established entities in their common bid to continually uphold quality education, thus, ensuring strong advocacy for high quality education that will redound to better provision of social services and all its related programs for the City's constituents;

WHEREAS, this august Body sees the need for the renewal of such Memorandum of Agreement relative to the contract of affiliation in order to help Medical Technology students gain enough knowledge and experiences in the field of medical services and to help address the needs of our constituents;

WHEREAS, the said MOA defines the terms and conditions intended for the affiliation and training of SLRC Medical Technology Intern students at LGU Health Centers and Clinical Laboratory so as to ensure high quality education for both undergraduate and prospective medical technology students;

WHEREAS, the Assistant City Legal Officer issued an indorsement along with an opinion dated January 19, 2018 stating that the MOA is in order, not detrimental to the interests of the City, not contrary to law, morals and public policy and recommends the approval of the aforementioned MOA, a copy of the said letter is hereto attached as Annex "B" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, the subject MOA clearly and plainly encapsulates the terms and conditions of the agreement of the parties thereto, including their specific roles and obligations towards the attainment of the lofty ends of the same, and this Sanggunian, upon thorough review, finds that the same is extremely favorable and advantageous to the institution and the communities that both parties are serving and therefore, is most deserving of this august Body's prompt and favorable consideration;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Benjamin S. Pongos Jr., Chairman, Committee on Laws and Ordinances, severally seconded by SP Members Tomas R. Serafica, Vincent L. Rama, Rolando M. Villasencio, Gregorio G. Yrastorza III, John Eulalio Nepomuceno O. Aparis II, Lea Doris C. Villar and Nolito M. Quilang; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass a RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This memorandum of agreement is entered into this _____ of _____, 20____ and between the following parties:

CITY GOVERNMENT OF ORMOC through the **CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT**, with official address at Ormoc City, Leyte, represented herein by **HON. RICHARD I. GOMEZ**, City Mayor, hereinafter referred to as the **FIRST PARTY**.

and

SAN LORENZO RUIZ COLLEGE of Ormoc, INC. (SLRC), an Educational Institution duly recognized in accordance with the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with official address at Barangay San Pablo, Ormoc City, represented herein by **DR. ADELINA Y. LARRAZABAL**, Vice-President/Administrator, hereinafter referred to as **SECOND PARTY**:

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the City Health Department is a government agency mandated to promote, protect, preserve or restore the health of the people through the provision and delivery of health services and through the regulation and encouragement of providers of health goods and services;

WHEREAS, the City Health Department, being Sentrong Sigla Certified, can accept student affiliates in medical and para medical discipline, as mandated in A. O. 9-C's 1997 on the IRR of AO No. 5-A s 1996 on the "Guidelines Governing Affiliation and Training of Students",

WHEREAS, the San Lorenzo Ruiz College of Ormoc, Inc., as an educational institution of higher learning, is mandated, through its curriculum to require her students to render community-based work in health-related services, as practicum and application of the students' academic and theoretical knowledge derived from the classroom; and as such, instituted the Community Extension Services (CES) unit of the school, mainly responsible in the integration and coordination of all community-based projects of the school;

NOW, THEREFORE and in consideration of the following premises the parties have agreed on the following stipulations:

1. That **CITY GOVERNMENT OF ORMOC** through the **CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT** shall:
 - a. Make available the organized community health services at San Pablo District Health Center for the necessary learning experience of Medical Technology students on community health which emphasizes the promotion of community, public and environmental health.
 - b. Designate a focal person to conduct program for the Clinical Instructors assigned by the school to supervise the students during their duties at the District Health Center.
 - c. Not allow students in the field practice area without the Clinical Instructors assigned by the school.
2. That **SAN LORENZO RUIZ COLLEGE of Ormoc** shall:
 - a. Provide licensed Medical Technologist as Clinical Instructors who will supervise and assist the students assigned at the San Pablo District Health Center.
 - b. Abide the rules and regulation of the Department of Health and the City Health Department on the implantation of health programs.
 - c. Coordinate with the City Health Officer II and San Pablo District Medical Officer.
 - d. Require to pay or replace damages, breakages or losses by the faculty and students at the San Pablo Health Center.
 - e. Pay the standard affiliation fee of One Hundred pesos (p100.00) per month per student which shall be treated as trust fund and utilized in accordance with A.O. 5-A, s 1996 of the Department of Health.
 - f. Be responsible for every action that may be committed by their students.

3. The Local Government of Ormoc City shall be free from any liability resulting from any untoward incident that may happen to the students in the course of their affiliation.
4. The term of this Memorandum of Agreement is for a period of three (3) years, from January 08, 2018 to January 07, 2021 and may be renewed on mutual behest of both parties.

In witness thereof, the parties hereby sign this Memorandum of Agreement which shall be valid and in full force and effect upon the signing of both parties.
