RESOLUTION NO. 2018-060

A RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. GCMEZ TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE MEMORANDIJM OF AGREEMENT (MOA), FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC (LGU-ORMOC) WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES (DENR) THROUGH THE ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT BUREAU-REGION VIII (EMB-8) FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A NATIONAL ECOSAVERS PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, this august Body was in receipt of an Indorsement (3rd Indorsement) from the Office of the City Mayor dated February 19, 2018, and was referred to the Office of SP Member Gregorio G. Yrastorza, III, as Chairman of the Committee on Erwironment and Natural Resources, and SP Member Benjamin S. Pongos, Jr., as Chairman of the Committee on Public Properties, through an Indorsement (4th Indorsement) dated February 22, 2018, requesting therein for the passage of a resolution granting the City Mayor Richard I. Gomez, authority to enter into and sign the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA), for and on behalf of the Local Government Unit of Ormoc (SECOND PARTY), with the Department of Environment and Resources (DENR) through the Environmental Natural Management Bureau - Region VIII (FIRST PARTY) for the establishment of a National Ecosavers Program in public Elementary and High Schools, a photocopy of the final Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) is hereto attached and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 (RA 9003), provides the legal framework for promoting the systematic, comprehensive and ecological measures for avoiding the generation of solid waste, reducing wastes and the final safe disposing of waste in order to protect public health and the environment;

WHEREAS, Section 8 of Republic Act No. 9003, known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 states mandates the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) to, among others, provide technical and other capability building assistance and support to the Local Government Units (LGUs) in the development and implementation of local solid waste management plans and programs;

WHEREAS, Article I, Section 2, Paragraph (g) of the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 (RA 9003) states that the Local Government Units (LGUs) have the primary enforcement and responsibility of solid waste management while establishing a cooperative effort among the national government, other local government units, non-governmental organizations, and the private sector;

WHEREAS, the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 (RA 9003) mandates the Local Government Units (LGUs) to provide efficient, reliable and universal collection services and environmentally safe disposal of wastes;

WHEREAS, the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) fosters the strategy of partnerships among stakeholders such as government agencies, non-governmental organizations (NGOs), youth in the private and public sector in the promotion of Ecological Solid Waste Management;

WHEREAS, the existing public school system within the Local Government Unit (LGU) is a valuable resource that can be tapped in the implementation of a local ecological management program;

WHEREAS, there is a need for the Local Government Unit of Ormoc (LGU-Ormoc) and the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) through the Environmental Management Bureau – Region VIII (EMB-VIII) to collaborate through execution of a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) for the purpose in order to establish a National Ecosavers Program in public Elementary and High Schools within Ormoc City:

WHEREAS, upon close and thorough review, this Sanggunian finds that the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) is not contrary to law, public policy, public morals and existing contracts, and that the aim of this project is highly noble in that together the City and the DENR EMB-8 will be undertaking a program that will greatly benefit the inhabitants of the City and its environment, so therefore, most deserving of this august Body's full support and affirmative action;

WHEREFORE, on joint motion of SP Member Gregorio G. Yrastorza III, Chairman, Committee on Environment and Natural Resources and SP Member Benjamin S. Pongos, Jr., Chairman on Public Properties, severally seconded by SP Members Lea Doris C. Villar, Mariano Y. Corro and John Eulalio Nepomuceno O. Aparis II; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass a RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. 

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This AGREEMENT made and entered into by and between:

The **DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES**, through the **ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT BUREAU REGION VIII** with principal office at DENR Compound, Jones St. Ext., Brgy.02, Tacloban City, represented by its Regional Director, **LETECIA R. MACEDA**, hereinafter referred to as **EMB**;

-And-

The LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC CITY located at Ormoc City. Leyte represented by its City Mayor, HON. RICHARD I. GOMEZ, hereinafter referred to as LGU ORMOC CITY.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act (RA 9003) provides the legal framework for promoting the systematic, comprehensive and ecological measures for avoiding the generation of solid waste, reducing wastes and the final safe disposing of waste in order to protect public health and the environment;

WHEREAS, Section 8 of RA 9003, mandates the DENR to, among others, provide technical and other capability building assistance and support to the Local Government Units (LGUs) in the development and implementation of local solid waste management plans and programs.

WHEREAS, the DENR fosters the strategy of partnerships among stakeholders such as government agencies, non-governmental organizations (NGOs), the youth in the private and public sector in the promotion of Ecological Solid Waste Management.

WHEREAS, Article I Section 2g of RA 9003 states that Local Government Units (LGUs) have the primary enforcement and responsibility of solid waste management while establishing a cooperative effort among the national government, other local government units, non-government organizations, and the private sector;

WHEREAS, RA 9003 mandates the LGUs to provide efficient, reliable, and universal collection services and environmentally safe disposal of wastes;

WHEREAS, the existing public school system within the LGU is a valuable resource that can be tapped in the implementation of a local ecological solid waste management program;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of these premises and the mutual covenants herein contained, the Parties do hereby agree as follows:

Section 1. Objectives

The Parties agree to collaborate in the establishment of a National Ecosavers Program (NEP) in public Elementary and High Schools in cooperation with concerned local City/Municipal governments with the following general objectives:

1

- Reduce the amount of solid waste generated by schools and/or houses through the collection of recyclable materials by elementary and high school students;
- 2. Encourage students even at a young age to practice waste segregation at source and collection of recyclable materials;
- 3. Establish the NEP in Public Elementary and High Schools with the following components:
 - Collection of recyclable materials from students;
 - Segregation of collected recyclable materials;
 - Establishment of a School Materials Recovery Facility (MRF);
 - Establishment of an incentive system (waste exchange) for the students who have collected the recyclable materials;
 - Establishment of other SWM activities that shall be income-generating for the school and the students in a prolonged scheme,
- 4. Establish a market for recyclables (or a recycle exchange system) by the implementing school; and
- 5. Document experiences / lessons learned and recommendations for implementation of the program in other urban centers of the country.

Section 2. Role of the DENR through the Environmental Management Bureau (EMB):

- 1. Provide technical and funding support to facilitate assistance to the Public Elementary and High Schools amounting to Forty Five Thousand Pesos (Php 45,000.00):
 - a. In enabling the schools to implement the NEP covered by this Agreement;
 - b. In formulating and implementing the NEP, establishment of Materials Recovery Facility (MRF), linking with junkshops for the marketing of recyclable wastes and determination of waste diversion as a result of the systems introduced; and
- 2. Provide the over-all coordination, monitoring with the implementing school to this Agreement to ensure the attainment of the objectives of the Agreement; and
- 3. Submit Quarterly Accomplishment/Progress and Final Reports, as well as Financial/Liquidation Report of the NEP implementation.

Section 3. Role of the LGU:

- 1. In collaboration with the selected implementing school, shall develop and submit a Work and Financial Plan for the activities that will be conducted which shall form part of this agreement;
- 2. Provide counterpart resources to assist/augment the implementation of this Agreement as follows:
 - Designate a Project Officer to facilitate coordination and implementation of the project; and
 - Provide financial or other forms of support for the project as covered by this Agreement, subject to availability of resources.
- 3. Shall be responsible of handling the fund and its liquidation directly to EMB Region VIII.



Section 4. Role of the Selected Implementing School:

- 1. Provide overall supervision in the implementation of the NEP;
- 2. Conduct information, education and communication campaigns among the students, School officials, faculty and other support staff; and
- 3. Document the experiences in implementing the program focusing on lessons learned, best practices and recommendations in implementing the NEP with the assistance of the partner organization.

Section 5. Joint Monitoring and Evaluation of Activities

The EMB Region VIII, partner LGU, **ORMOC CITY**, and the implementing school, **IPIL CENTRAL SCHOOL**, shall jointly monitor and evaluate activities conducted under this Agreement to ensure attainment of the set objectives.

Section 6. Auditing Procedures

The Parties shall be subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Section 7. Amendments

By mutual consent, this Agreement or part hereof may be modified, repealed, altered, extended, revised, amended or supplemented by the Parties to ensure that the objectives of this Agreement are achieved.

Section 8. Effectivity

This MOA shall take effect upon signing hereof by the Parties and shall continue to be in full force and effect until the completion of the agreements mentioned herein.
