RESOLUTION NO. 2018-086

A RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I GOMEZ OR THE ACTING CITY MAYOR, TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM UNDERSTANDING (MOU) FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC (LGU-ORMOC) WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT (DOLE) RELATIVE TO THE OPERATION OF THE DOLE JOB PROVIDE MARKET KIOSK LABOR TO INFORMATION AND EMPLOYMENT FACILITATION

WHEREAS, an Indorsement was forwarded to this august Body from the Office of the City Mayor dated April 3, 2018 requesting for the issuance of a Resolution authorizing the City Mayor to enter into and sign the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) necessary for the operation of the Job Search Kiosks by the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE), a copy of the Memorandum of Understanding is hereto attached as Annex 'A" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, the DOLE is mandated to promote gainful employment opportunities, develop human resources, protect workers and promote their welfare, and maintain industrial peace;

WHEREAS, DOLE, in pursuance of its mandate to provide labor market information (LMI) and to facilitate employment, operates the DOLE Job Search Kiosk, a stand-alone labor market information system capable of employment facilitation like job search and matching skills facility;

WHEREAS, the Job Search Kiosk (JSK) is an information portal housed in an ATM-type, stand-alone equipment, which provides information on local/overseas job opportunities and other employment related information and helps job seekers to fast-track access to relevant information on job openings, hiring requirements of employers or upgrade, their skills through the TESDA programs and BLE career guides;

WHEREAS, the deployment of the kiosks is a boost to sustaining the progress of employment facilitation and in investing in the country's human resource as pillars of decent work towards inclusive growth;

WHEREAS, the task of facilitating job matching and placement of job seekers as one of DOLE's strategies is enriched with the aid of information and communications technology and the JSK serves as a virtual jobs fair site which will regularly churn out employment opportunities in the job market;

WHEREAS, DOLE desires to expand its reach and enable registered jobseekers to access more employment opportunities at no charge to them;

WHEREAS, the Public Employment Service Offices (PESO) are maintained largely by the LGUs and linked to the regional offices of the DOLE and to the DOLE Central Office for coordination and technical supervision and under the PESO Act of 1999, constitutes the national employment service network;

WHEREAS, the DOLE is desirous of providing and establishing one (1) Job Search Kiosk at a suitable area in the Ormoc City Hall and the City Government of Ormoc is willing to provide the same as it is needed to propel the City's employment provision initiatives to its constituents;

WHEREAS, the parties herein have committed to collaborating with each other thru this MOU with full knowledge, commitment and willingness in the fulfillment of their responsibilities contained thereon;

WHEREAS, the City Legal Officer issued an opinion dated March 27, 2018 stating that the MOU is in order, not detrimental to the interests of the City, not contrary to law, morals and public policy and recommends the approval of the aforementioned MOU, a copy of which is hereto attached as Annex "B" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, upon close and thorough review, this Sanggunian, finds that the MOU is not contrary to law, existing contracts and public morals, and that its objectives are extremely beneficial to the City in that they aim to facilitate employment to Ormocanons and so therefore, most deserving of this august Body's full support and affirmative action to the same;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Benjamin S. Pongos Jr., Chairman, Committee on Laws and Ordinances, severally seconded by SP Members Mariano Y. Corro, Mario M. Rodriguez, Tomas R. Serafica, and John Eulalio Nepomuceno O. Aparis II; be it
