## RESOLUTION NO. 2018-140

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PROJECT OF UPGRADING AND/OR IMPROVEMENT OF ORMOC CITY SLAUGHTERHOUSE TO BE FUNDED OUT OF THE CITY'S SHARE OF THE DEVELORMENT AND LIVELIHOOD FUND (DLF) OF ENERGY REGULATION (ER) 1-94

WHEREAS, the 14th Sangguniang Panlungsod received a Project Proposal for the Upgrading and/or improvement of Ormoc City Slaughterhouse to be funded out of the City's Share of the Development and Livelihood Fund (DLF) as provided under Energy Regulation (ER) 1-94 through an endorsement from the Office of the City Mayor Richard I. Gomez dated May 15, 2018;

WHEREAS, Republic Act (RA) 9136 otherwise known as the Electric Power Industry Reform Act (EPIRA) of 2001 mandates that "the obligations of generation companies and energy resource developers to communities hosting energy generating facilities and/or energy resource developers shall continue";

Wit EREAS, pursuant to Section 5 (i) of Republic Act No. 7638, otherwise known as the "Department of Energy Act of 1992," the Department shall "devise ways and means of giving direct benefits to the province, city, or municipality, especially the community and people affected, and equitable preferential benefit to the region that hosts the energy resource and/or the energy-generating facility: Provided, however, that the other provinces, cities, municipalities, or regions shall not be deprived of their energy requirements.":

WHEREAS, Energy Regulations (ER) No. 1-94 issued on 24 May 1994 prescribed the provision of direct benefits to pertinent local government units hosting energy resources and/or energy-generating facilities within their territorial jurisdiction, pursuant to Section 5 (i) of Republic Act No. 7638 (Department of Energy Act of 1992);

WHEREAS, Energy Regulations No. (ER) 1-94 provides that one-centavo per kilowatt-hour (P0.01/kWh) of the Electricity Sales will be allocated to apply for Generation Facilities and/or energy resource development projects located in all barangays, municipalities, cities, provincies and regions;

Section 6, Paragraph g, Sub-Paragraph 1 of Energy Regulations No. (ER) 1-94 entitled Development and Livelihood Fund, provides that consistent with Section 5 of Republic Act No. 7638, all power producers shall set aside twenty-five percent (25%) of one centavo (P 0.0025) per kilowatt-hour of the total electricity sales of the energy-generating facility to establish and maintain a development and livelihood fund;

WHEREAS, Establishment or Rehabilitation of a City Slaughterhouse is one of the projects allowed under the Development Projects to be funded by the Development and Livelihood Fund (DLF) of ER 1-94;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Environment and Natural Resources and the Committee on Energy Conservation, after thorough deliberation, approved to endorse to the Department of Energy – Manila, the project proposal of Upgrading or Improvement of Ormoc City Slaughterhouse to be funded out of the City's Share of the Development and Livelihood Fund (DLF) of Energy Regulation (ER) 1-94 benefits from Mahanagdong and Malitbog Geothermal Power Plant at the Committee Level on a Joint Committee Meeting held last May 28, 2018 at the Sangguniang Panlungsod (SP) Session Hall;

WHEREAS, after careful review on the matter, this 14<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Panlungsod finds that the project is not contrary to law, public policy, public morals and existing contracts, and that the aim of this project is highly noble in that together the City and the Department of Energy (DOE) will be undertaking a project that will greatly benefit the inhabitants of the City and its environment, so therefore, most deserving of this august Body's full support and affirmative action, and decided to pass a Resolution Endorsing and Interposing No Objection to said project;

WHEREFORE, FOREGOING PREMISES CONSIDERED, on joint motion of SP Member Gregorio G. Yrastorza, III, Chairman, Committee on Environment and Natural Resources, and SP Member Benjamin S. Pongos, Jr., Member, Committee on Energy Conservation, severally seconded by SP Members Vincent L. Rama, Tomas R. Serafica and Mariano Y. Corro; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass a RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PROJECT OF UPGRADING AND/OR IMPROVEMENT OF ORMOC CITY SLAUGHTERHOUSE TO BE FUNDED OUT OF THE CITY'S SHARE OF THE DEVELOPMENT AND LIVELIHOOD FUND (DLF) OF ENERGY REGULATION (ER) 1-94;

ADOPTED, June 14, 2018.
