RESOLUTION NO. 2018-159

A RESOLUTION SUPERSEDING SP RESOLUTION NO. 2018-140, ENTITLED: "A RESOLUTION INTERPOSING NO OBJECTION TO THE PROJECT OF UPGRADING AND/OR IMPROVEMENT OF ORMOC CITY SLAUGHTERHOUSE TO BE FUNDED OUT OF THE CITY'S SHARE OF ENERGY REGULATION (ER) 1-94".

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2018-140, entitled: "A RESOLUTION INTERPOSING NO OBJECTION TO THE PROJECT OF UPGRADING AND/OR IMPROVEMENT OF ORMOC CITY SLAUGHTERHOUSE TO BE FUNDED OUT OF THE CITY'S SHARE OF ENERGY REGULATION (ER) 1-94" was passed and approved by the 14th Sangguniang Panlungsod during the Regular Plenary Session last June 14, 2018;

WHEREAS, the 14th Sangguniang Panlungsod received an endorsement from the Office of the City Mayor Richard I. Gomez dated June 22, 2018 requesting for a Resolution amending Resolution No. 2018-140;

WHEREAS, Republic Act (RA) 9136 otherwise known as the Electric Power Industry Reform Act (EPIRA) of 2001 mandates that "*the obligations of generation companies and energy resource developers to communities hosting energy generating facilities and/or energy resource developers shall continue*";

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5 (i) of Republic Act No. 7638, otherwise known as the "Department of Energy Act of 1992," *the Department shall "devise ways and means of giving direct benefits to the province, city, or municipality, especially the community and people affected, and equitable preferential benefit to the region that hosts the energy resource and/or the energy-generating facility: Provided, however, that the other provinces, cities, municipalities, or regions shall not be deprived of their energy requirements";*

WHEREAS, Energy Regulations (ER) No. 1-94 issued on 24 May 1994 prescribed for the list of projects allowed under this regulation which will be funded under its two (2) separate funds, the Development and Livelihood Fund (DLF) and the Reforestation Watershed Management and/on Environment Enhancement Fund (RWMEEF);

WHEREAS, Establishment or Rehabilitation of a City Slaughterhouse and its Water Facilities, Procurement of Equipment and other Facilities are few of the projects allowed under the Development and Livelihood Fund (DLF) and the Reforestation Watershed Management and/on Environment Enhancement Fund (RWMEEF) of Energy Regulation (ER) 1-94;

WHEREAS, in order to have projects that are eligible to be funded by said funds and/or receive the full benefits provided by Energy Regulations (ER) No. 1-94, Resolution No. 2018-140 must be superseded to state that the proposed project will be funded out from the City's share of Energy Regulations (ER) No. 1-94 and not only by its Development and Livelihood Fund (DLF),

WHEREAS, after careful review on the matter, this 14th Sangguniang Panlungsod finds that the amendment is necessary, is not contrary to law, public policy, public morals and existing contracts, and that the aim of this Resolution is to receive the full benefits provided by Energy Regulations (ER) No. 1-94 that will greatly benefit the inhabitants of the City and its environment through the realization of the proposed project, so therefore, most deserving of this august Body's full support and affirmative action;

WHEREFORE, FOREGOING PREMISES CONSIDERED, on joint motion of SP Member Gregorio G. Yrastorza III, Chairman, Committee on Environment & Natural Resources and SP Member Mario M. Rodriguez, Member, Committee on Energy Conservation, duly seconded by SP Member Tomas R. Serafica; be it


