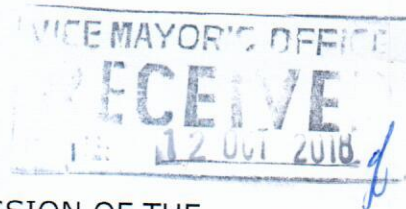

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RESOLUTION NO. 2018-260

A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ OR THE ACTING CITY MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA), FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF ORMOC (LGU-ORMOC), WITH THE ROAD BOARD AND DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (DILG) FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE PROVINCIAL AND CITY ROADS LOCATIONAL REFERENCING SYSTEM (LRS) AND CONDUCT OF ROAD INVENTORY.

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Mayor through an Endorsement dated September 17, 2018, forwarded to this august Body for consideration the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA), to be entered into by the Local Government Unit of Ormoc (LGU-Ormoc) with the Road Board and the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) for the establishment of the Local [sic] Referencing System, a copy of the final MOA is hereto attached as Annex "A" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, Republic Act (R.A.) No. 8794, otherwise known as the Motor Vehicle User's Charge (MVUC) Law was enacted to provide for, and ensure the adequate maintenance of national, provincial and city roads;

WHEREAS, the Road Board, created under R.A. No. 8794, ensures and oversees the optimum utilization of resources for the maintenance and improvement of a safe, efficient and environmentally balanced road network;

WHEREAS, the DILG, as one of its services, conducts a road inventory and condition survey of city and provincial roads, as requested by the Road Board;

WHEREAS, the MVUC Law allocates five percent (5%) of its funds for the Special Local Road Fund (SLRF) which is apportioned for the maintenance of provincial and city roads on the basis of vehicle population and length of the road network for each locality;

WHEREAS, the Locational Referencing System (LRS) is a road mapping project which aims to help the local government units in all provinces and cities nationwide in updating the country's road network inventory;

WHEREAS, the said project aims to include the provision of global positioning system (GPS) road centerline and inventory of all provincial and city roads;

WHEREAS, a reliable local road inventory is a vital mechanism to guide the Road Board and local governments in planning, managing and prioritizing the maintenance of local roads;

WHEREAS, LGU-Ormoc, through the same, would be able to increase its use of information technology to maintain an accurate inventory of its road networks;

WHEREAS, there is a need to ensure the effective implementation of the aforementioned project and the efficient utilization of funds, hence, authority to sign the MOA is essential;

WHEREAS, the responsibilities of the LGU-Ormoc, among others, is to designate a focal person for the project, provide counterpart staff and funds for fuel and costs of labor and materials, install the kilometer posts, validate the inventory of roads and approve route plan for the conduct of the surveys based on the approved road inventory and provide secondary data for the road inventory;

WHEREAS, LGU-Ormoc is willing to enter into a MOA with the Road Board and the DILG as the establishment of the provincial and City Roads LRS and conduct of road inventory would be beneficial to the City;

WHEREAS, in a certification dated September 14, 2018, issued by the City Engineer, said document states that the Office of the City Engineer has available funds for fuel, labor and materials cost for the Conduct of Roads and Bridges Inventory Survey— Phase I and the installation of Kilometer Posts— Phase II, a copy of said certification is hereto attached as Annex "B" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, the City Legal Officer, Atty. Jasper M. Lucero, issued a legal opinion dated July 27, 2018 expressing that after a review of the terms of the aforementioned MOA, finds that the same is in compliance with the provisions of R.A. No. 8794 or the Motor Vehicle User's Charge (MVUC) Law, is in order, not detrimental to the interests of the City, not contrary to law, morals and public policy and further recommends that an SP Resolution be secured for the Authority of the Mayor to sign the draft MOA, a copy of said letter is hereto attached as Annex "C" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, upon close and thorough review, this Sanggunian finds that the aforementioned MOA is advantageous and for the best interest of the City and its inhabitants, and that this august Body finds that the project would be able to effectively standardize the method and format in coming up with a comprehensive local roads inventory and condition survey vital to planning, managing and prioritizing the maintenance by the City of its own roads in order to address the constraints and major challenges faced by the city in its road system brought by rapid urbanization, and therefore necessitates prompt favorable action by this Sanggunian;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Benjamin S. Pongos, Jr., Chairman of the Committee on Laws and Ordinances, severally seconded by SP Members Vincent L. Rama, Tomas R. Serafica and Esteban V. Laurente; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass a RESOLUTION GRANTING THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ OR THE ACTING CITY MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA), FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF ORMOC (LGU-ORMOC), WITH THE ROAD BOARD AND DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (DILG) FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE PROVINCIAL AND CITY ROADS LOCATIONAL REFERENCING SYSTEM (LRS) AND CONDUCT OF ROAD INVENTORY;

ADOPTED, October 11, 2018.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished each to the City Mayor, Richard I. Gomez; the City Administrator, Mr. Vincent L. Ennas; City Legal Officer, Atty. Jasper M. Lucero; the Department of Interior and Local Government Regional Office VIII; the Road Board; the OIC-City Director, DILG; and other concerned offices, for their information and guidance.
