**RESOLUTION NO. 2018-329**

**A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC CITY WITH THE PHILIPPINE FIBER INDUSTRY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY, FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT/PROVISION OF PINEAPPLE PROCESSING CENTER.**

WHEREAS, the 14<sup>TH</sup> Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc received an endorsement letter from the Office of the City Mayor on December 27, 2018, the request for the issuance of a Resolution granting authority to the City Mayor to sign a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to be entered into by the Local Government Unit of Ormoc City (LGU-ORMOC) and the Philippine Fiber Industry Development Authority (PhilFIDA) represented by its Executive Director, Kennedy T. Costales for the establishment/provision of Pineapple Processing Center, a copy of the final MOA is hereto attached as Annex "A" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, there is a wide area of land planted with pineapple of queen variety in the City of Ormoc and nearby municipalities;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Fiber Industry Development Authority, as the lead agency responsible for the development of the fiber industry, will coordinate with the City of Ormoc in the establishment of Pineapple Fiber Processing Center, Fiber Stripping Shed and Drying Shed, equipped with handloom with other weaving tools and devices, sewing machines, twisting device, Multi-Fiber Decorticating Machines (MFDM) and furnitures;



WHEREAS, the LGU-ORMOC is willing to act as Co-implementer through the provision of counterpart support, primarily by providing a government lot of not less than One Thousand square meters (1,000 sq. m.) for the establishment of three buildings, namely: Pineapple Fiber Processing Center, Fiber Stripping Shed and Drying Shed;

WHEREAS, after review of the draft MOA by the City Legal Officer of the City, Atty. Josephine A. Mejia-Romero, she finds it not contrary to law, morals, good customs, public policy and public order recommending that a Sangguniang Panlungsod Resolution be secured for the Authority of the Mayor to sign the same, a copy of the letter is hereto attached as Annex "B" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, upon close and thorough review, this Sanggunian finds the aforementioned request by the City Mayor advantageous and for the best interest of the City and its inhabitants, therefore, meriting this august Body's full support and favorable action;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of SP Tomas R. Serafica, Chairman - Committee on Agriculture, Fisheries and Agrarian Reform, duly seconded by SP Member Esteban V. Laurente; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC CITY WITH THE PHILIPPINE FIBER INDUSTRY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY, FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT/PROVISION OF PINEAPPLE PROCESSING CENTER;

This Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) made and entered into this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2019 by and between:

The **Philippine Fiber Industry Development Authority**, a national government agency mandated to accelerate the growth and development of the fiber industry, represented herein by its Executive Director, **KENNEDY T. COSTALES**, with office address at 3F DA-PCAF Bldg. Department of Agriculture Compound, Elliptical Road, Diliman, Quezon City hereinafter referred to as **PhilFIDA**;

-and-

The **Local Government Unit (LGU) of Ormoc City** with principal address at New Ormoc City Hall, Aunubing St., Brgy. Cogon, Ormoc City herein represented by its City Mayor, **RICHARD I. GOMEZ**, hereinafter referred to as **LGU**;

- Witnesseth -

WHEREAS, **PhilFIDA**, as the lead agency responsible for the development of the fiber industry, will coordinate with the City of Ormoc in the Province of Leyte in the establishment of Pineapple Fiber Processing Center, Fiber Stripping Shed and Drying Shed, equipped with digital weighing scale (100 kg capacity), sewing machines, twisting device, five (5) units of Multi-Fiber Decorticating Machines (MFDM) and furniture;

WHEREAS, the **LGU** is willing to act as Co-Implementor through the provision of counterpart fund support;

WHEREAS, there is a wide area of land planted with pineapple of queen variety in the City of Ormoc and nearby municipalities;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the above premises, the parties hereto agreed on the following:

1. That the **PhilFIDA** shall:

- 1.1 Provide a Pineapple Fiber Processing Center, Fiber Stripping Shed and Drying Shed, equipped with digital weighing scale (100 kg capacity), sewing machines, twisting device, five (5) units of Multi-Fiber Decorticating Machines (MFDM) and furniture;
- 1.2 Provide training to the beneficiaries on the Operation and Maintenance of the Multi-Fiber Decorticating Machine, Extraction of Natural Dyes and Dyeing Process.
- 1.3 Provide technical assistance on fiber processing and provide linkages in the marketing of the produced product;



- 1.4 Assign at least one (1) technician to oversee and coordinate project implementation, conduct of benchmark surveys and monitoring and evaluation.
  - 1.5 Coordinate closely with LGU City Agriculture Office (CAO) and other agencies in the implementation, operation and regular monitoring and evaluation of the regular activities; and,
  - 1.5 Have the option to donate the digital weighing scale (100kg capacity), sewing machines, MFDM and twining device to the LGU provided that the LGU will continuously monitored the utilization of the said units for a period of five (5) years.
2. That the **LGUs** shall:
- 2.1 Provide a government-owned lot of not less than 1,000 square-meter for the establishment of the three buildings, namely: Pineapple Fiber Processing Center, Fiber Stripping Shed, and Drying Shed;
  - 2.2 Transfer the Pineapple Fiber Processing Center, Fiber Stripping Shed, Drying Shed, digital weighing scale (100kg capacity), sewing machines, MFDM, twisting device, furniture and other facilities at no cost to the association/cooperative;
  - 2.4 Assign the CAO to work closely with PhilFIDA in the implementation of the project, and,
  - 2.5 Have the option to select or assign any association/cooperative to operate the facility for the intended purpose.



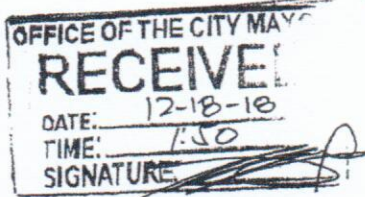
