RESOLUTION NO. 2019-029

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY RICHARD I GOMEZ TO CAUSE THE DEMOLITION OF SHOPPING MALL BUILDING LOCATED CORNERS REAL, LOPEZ JAENA, AND RIZAL STREETS, ORMOG CITY INCLUDING THE AUTHORITY TO PERFORM ALK NECESSARY ACTS ACCOMPLISHMENT OF THE SAME, SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION ON AUDIT (CON) AND OTHER GOVERNMENT AGENCIES.

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian was in receipt of an Endorsement dated August 5, 2019 from the Office of the City Mayor requesting for the passage of a Resolution granting him authority to cause the demolition of the Shopping Mall Building located at corners Real, Lopez Jaena, and Rizal Streets, Ormoc City, including the authority to perform all acts for the accomplishment of the same, subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Commission on Audit (COA) and other Government Agencies;

WHEREAS, Section 379 of the Local Government Code explicitly provides that when property of any local government unit has become unserviceable for any cause or is no longer needed, it shall, upon application of the officer accountable therefore, be inspected and appraised by the provincial, city or municipal auditor, as the case may be, or his duly authorized representative or that of the Commission on Audit and, if found valueless or unusable, shall be destroyed in the presence of the inspecting officer;

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WHEREAS, further, pursuant to Section 79 of PD 1445, it is also mandated that "When government property has become unserviceable for any cause or no longer needed, it shall, upon application of the officer accountable therefore, be inspected by the head of the agency or of his duly authorized representative";

WHEREAS, in a communication dated June 24, 2019, from Engr. Domardoni C. Cayanong, City General Services Officer, addressed to City Mayor Richard I. Gomez, the former had endorsed to the latter the Inventory and Inspection Report of Unserviceable Property for the shopping mall bounded along Real, Lopez Jaena and Rizal Streets, Ormoc City, as the same is considered a public nuisance, ruinous and dangerous after considering the findings of the post-fire structural assessment and after careful evaluation of the structure by the Office of the Building Official, a copy of which is hereto attached as Annex "A" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, an endorsement dated July 15, 2019, from Engr. Domardoni C. Cayanong, City General Services Officer, addressed to Rosario G. Serafica, Chairperson-City Disposal Committee, endorsing documents pertinent to cause the demolition of the Shopping Mall and further requesting to provide the Ledger Card and Certification of the appraised value of the property before forwarding the same to the Office of the Commission on Audit for their Appraisal and Review, a copy of the endorsement is hereto attached as Annex "B" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Accountant issued a Property Plant and Equipment Ledger Card and a Certification of the appraised value of the Shopping Mall dated June 25, 2019, stating therein that said property has a Net Book Value of Twenty-Two Million, Five Hundred Seventy-Nine Thousand, Toree Hundred Eighty-Five Philippine Pesos and 99/100 (PHP22,579,385.99) as of June 21, 2019, a copy of the Property Plant and Equipment Ledger Card and Certification are hereto attached as Annex "C" and "D", respectively and made integral parts hereof;

WHEREAS, the City Disposal Committee on July 26, 2019 endorsed documents pertinent to the City's proposed demolition of the Shopping Mall to the Office of the City Mayor for further endorsement to the Commission on Audit for the latter's appraisal and review, a copy of the endorsement is hereto attached as Annex "E" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, upon close and thorough review, this Sanggunian finds, that the requested authorization to the City Mayor will further facilitate the expeditious disposal of unserviceable property and aid the disposal committee to undertake the disposition of said property, subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Commission on Audit (COA) and other government agencies and that the same is most beneficial to the City, therefore, meriting this august Body's full support and favorable action;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Roiland H. Villasencio, Chairman, Committee on Public Properties, severally seconded by SP Members Jasper M. Lucero, Vincent L. Rama, Gregorio G. Yrastorza III and Lalaine A. Marcos; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass A RESOLUTON AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ TO CAUSE THE DEMOLITION OF THE SHOPPING MALL BUILDING LOCATED AT CORNERS REAL, LOPEZ JAENA, AND RIZAL STREETS, ORMOC CITY, INCLUDING THE AUTHORITY TO PERFORM ALL NECESSARY ACTS FOR THE ACCOMPLISHMENT OF THE SAME, SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION ON AUDIT (COA) AND OTHER GOVERNMENT AGENCIES;

ADOPTED, August 13, 2019.

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RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish copies of this resolution each to the City Mayor of Ormoc Richard I. Gomez; the City Administrator; the City Legal Officer; the City General Services Officer; the City Accountant; the City Disposal Committee; the Commission on Audit; the City Local Government Operations Officer-DILG; and all other offices concerned.


