RESOLUTION NO. 2019-073

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR ACCREDITATION WITH THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE **PROVISIONS** ORDINANCE NO. 009 DATED **OCTOBER** 2014 OF 16, **LEYTE** THE ORMOC TRANSPORT COOPERATIVE (LOTC).

WHEREAS, this august Body is in receipt of application for accreditation of the aforementioned civil society organizations requesting for membership in the Local Special Bodies as provided for in Rule XIII of the Rules and Regulations Implementing the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, it can be recalled that this Sanggunian has enacted Ordinance No. 009 dated October 16, 2014 entitled: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE ACCREDITATION OF CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS (CSOs) IN THE CITY OF ORMOC" which governs the procedures for Accreditation of legitimate organizations in the City of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, Section 2.1 of the same Ordinance provides among others that an organization may still be accredited after the prescribed sixty – day (60) period within which application for accreditation for membership in the Local Special Bodies by any organization shall be accepted, for purposes other than representation to the Local Special Bodies;

WHEREAS, LOTC, duly registered with the Cooperative and Development Authority on July 10, 2018, is a cooperative composed of transport operators and holders of valid and subsisting Certificates of Public Convenience, who organized themselves in response to the government's Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program and likewise to gain access to common resources, better fleet management system, efficient collection and ensure more effective franchise records management system;

WHEREAS, the call for accreditation of Civil Society Organizations was caused by the Fifteenth Sangguniang Panlungsod in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No. 009, which governs the procedures for accreditation of legitimate organizations in the City of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian, after thorough review of the aforementioned application for accreditation, finds that the same is in order, and the purposes of the sought accreditation are all directed to promote socio-economic development among its members through the establishment of a strong linkage with the local government unit in order for each organization to have a better access to the diverse programs and projects of the government that are beneficial to all sectors of the community;

WHEREAS, FURTHER, this august Body deems the application to be lawful being in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No. 009 hence, most deserving of favorable action by this Sanggunian;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Sangguniang Panlungsod Member Roiland H. Villasencio, Chairman, Committee on Cooperatives and Accreditation of Non-Government Organizations, severally seconded by SP Members Tomas R. Serafica, Vincent L. Rama, Jasper M. Lucero, Gregorio G. Yrastorza III and Esteban V. Laurente; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR ACCREDITATION WITH THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 009 DATED OCTOBER 16, 2014 OF THE LEYTE ORMOC TRANSPORT COOPERATIVE (LOTC);
