## RESOLUTION NO. 2019-074

AN OMNIBUS RESOLUTION APPROVING THE THREE (3)
SEPARATE APPLICATIONS FOR REMEWAL OF
ACCREDITATION WITH THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT
UNIT OF ORMOC, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE
PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 009 DATED
OCTOBER 16, 2014 OF THE FOLLOWING CIVIL
SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS, TO WIT:

- 1. ORMOC VENDORS MULTI-PURPOSE COOPERATIVE (ORVENPED);
- 2. STO. NIÑO VISARES TRANSPORT SERVICE MULTIPURPOSE COOPERATIVE (SAVIMCO); AND 3. PEOPLE'S TRANSPORT COOPERATIVE (PETCO).

WHEREAS, this august Body is in receipt of three (3) separate applications for renewal of accreditation of the aforementioned civil society organizations requesting for membership in the Local Special Bodies as provided for in Rule XIII of the Rules and Regulations Implementing the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, it can be recalled that this Sanggunian has enacted Ordinance No. 009 dated October 16, 2014 entitled: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE ACCREDITATION OF CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS (CSOs) IN THE CITY OF ORMOC" which governs the procedures for Accreditation of legitimate organizations in the City of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, Section 2.1 of the same Ordinance provides among others that an organization may still be accredited after the prescribed sixty – day (60) period within which applications for accreditation for membership in the Local Special Bodies by any organization shall be accepted, for purposes other than representation to the Local Special Bodies;

WHEREAS, ORVEMPCO, duly registered with the Cooperative Development Authority on November 22, 1993, is a cooperative which seeks to provide quality financial products and related service to improve the socio-economic conditions of members and in furtherance thereof, the cooperative commits to help their scholars – deserving students – to continue their education;

WHEREAS, SAVIMCO, duly registered with the Cooperative Development Authority on October 26, 2009, is a cooperative which establish seeks to develop sustainable livelihood among their members through the conduct of numerous activities and trainings, such as but not limited to the establishment of SAVIMCO Feeds Association and Coco Twining Trainings;

WHEREAS, PETCO, duly registered with the Cooperative Development Authority on April 25, 2018, is a cooperative which was organized in anticipation of the Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program of the government, to this end, it seeks to unite its members and continue the latter's livelihood in transport operations. Further, the cooperative seeks to provide safe, convenient and reliable transport service to the riding public;

WHEREAS, the call for accreditation of Civil Society Organizations was caused by the Fifteenth Sangguniang Panlungsod in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No. 009 dated October 16, 2014 entitled: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE ACCREDITATION OF CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS (CSOs) IN THE CITY OF ORMOC" which governs the procedures for accreditation of legitimate organizations in the City of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian, after thorough review of the aforementioned three (3) separate applications for renewal of accreditation, finds that the same are in order, and the purposes of the sought accreditation are all directed to promote socio-economic development among its members through the establishment of a strong linkage with the local government unit in order for each organization to have a better access to the diverse programs and projects of the government that are beneficial to all sectors of the community;

WHEREAS, FURTHER, this august Body deems the application to be lawful being in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No. 009 hence, most deserving of favorable action by this Sanggunian;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Roiland H. Villasencio, Chairman, Committee on Cooperatives and Accreditation of Non-Government Organizations, severally seconded by SP Members Tomas R. Serafica, Nolito M. Quilang, Eusebio Gerardo S. Penserga, Jasper M. Lucero, Vincent L. Raman, Gregorio G. Yrastroza III, Laiaine A. Marcos and Esteban V. Laurente; be it
