RESOLUTION NO. 2019-080

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY TREASURER TO CLOSE THE EXISTING ORMOC CITY LGU DOE ACCOUNT ER 1-94 PROJECT OF STREET LIGHTING, WITH THE ACCOUNT NUMBER 05422-765-6 AND 0765-012423-030 AT DEVELOPMENT BANK OF THE PHILIPPINES (DBP).

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod was in receipt of an Indorsement Letter from the City Mayor's Office (CMO), relative to a request of Ms. Alicia C. Dimapingun, OIC-City Treasurer, dated September 10, 2019, for the closure of ORMOC CITY LGU DOE ACCOUNT ER 1-94 PROJECT OF STREET LIGHTING, WITH THE ACCOUNT NUMBER 05422-765-6 and 0765-012423-030 at DBP to avoid future bank charges and penalties;

WHEREAS, the City of Ormoc has opened and maintained accounts with Development Bank of the Philippines (DBP) - Ormoc Branch, taking into consideration Section 311 of the Local Government Code (RA 7160) that provides: "[I]ocal treasurers shall maintain depository accounts in the name of their respective local government units with banks, preferably government-owned, located in or nearest to their respective areas of jurisdiction";

WHEREAS, the City of Ormoc opened the accounts 05422-765-6 AND 0765-012423-030 last 2009 at DBP the purpose of Project Street lighting to which was already completed and the bank account long time dormant;

WHEREAS, as of September 6, 2019, the account was reactivated to process a Transfer to General Fund resulting to a bank amount below the maintaining balance;

WHEREAS, the City Treasurer in a letter to the City Mayor dated September 9, 2019 recommended that since this is a Trust Fund and the project for this purpose was already completed, the bank account needs to be closed to avoid future charges and penalties as it is already below the maintaining balance;

WHEREAS, this sanggunian authorizes the City Treasurer to close the bank account at DBP and to transfer any remaining balance of the account towards the General Fund;

WHEREFORE, FOREGOING PREMISES CONSIDERED, on motion of SP Member Peter M. Rodriguez, Chairman, Committee on Finance & Appropriation, severally seconded by SP Members Tomas R. Serafica, Nolito M. Quilang, Jasper M. Lucero, Vincent L. Rama, Gregorio G. Yrastorza III, Lalaine A. Marcos and Esteban V. Laurente; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY TREASURER TO CLOSE THE EXISTING ORMOC CITY LGU DOE ACCOUNT ER 1-94 PROJECT OF STREET LIGHTING, WITH THE ACCOUNT NUMBER 05422-765-6 AND 0765-012423-030 AT DEVELOPMENT BANK OF THE PHILIPPINES (DBP);
