RESOLUTION NO. 2019-101

AN OMNIBUS RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FOUR (4)
SEPARATE APPLICATIONS FOR ACCREDITATION
WITH THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC, IN
ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF
ORDINANCE NO. 009 DATED OCTOBER 16, 2014 OF
THE FOLLOWING CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS,
TO WIT:

- 1. SELF-HELP ASSOCIATION FOR RIGHTS AND EMPOWERMENT (SHARE) ORMOC;
- 2. ORMOC CITY DIVISION PTA FEDERATION;
- 3 UNITED ORMOC KANANGA TRANSPORT
- 4. SABANG, VALENCIA, MATICA-A TRANSPORT COOPERATIVE (SAVAMTCO).

WHEREAS, it can be recalled that this Sanggunian has enacted Ordinance No. 009 dated October 16, 2014 entitled: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE ACCREDITATION OF CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS (CSOs) IN THE CITY OF ORMOC" which governs the procedures for Accreditation of legitimate organizations in the City of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, Section 2.1 of the same Ordinance provides among others that an organization may still be accredited after the prescribed sixty – day (60) period within which applications for accreditation for membership in the Local Special Bodies by any organization shall be accepted, for purposes other than representation to the Local Special Bodies;

WHEREAS, this august Body is in receipt of four (4) separate applications for accreditation of the aforementioned civil society organizations requesting for membership in the Local Special Bodies as provided for in Rule XIII of the Rules and Regulations Implementing the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, SHARE, duly registered with the Department of Labor and Employment on 22 December 2016, is an organization which seeks to promote moral, social and economic well-being of their members, to this end, they design and undertake activities, for the benefit and welfare of its members and the organization itself, including housing and other income-generating projects to lessen the negative conditions of the poor families;

WHEREAS, Ormoc City Division PTA Federation, duly registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission on 24 July 2002, is an aggrupation of all Board of Directors of District Parents – Teachers Association in this City, which seeks to elevate countryside from poverty and provide technical and livelihood to parents in every community they are present;

WHEREAS, United Ormoc Kananga Transport Cooperative, duly registered with the Cooperative Development Authority on 20 March 2018, is a transport cooperative with office address at Brgy. Concepcion, Ormoc City, which seeks to help improve the quality of life of its members and thereby contribute to their inclusive growth, enterprise development and employment. In furtherance thereof, the cooperative developed a dynamic savings mobilization and capital build up schemes to sustain its developmental activities and long-term investments;

WHEREAS, SAVAMTCO, duly registered with the Cooperative Development Authority on 25 April 2018, is a cooperative which was organized in anticipation of the Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program of the government, to this end, it seeks to unite its members and continue the latter's livelihood in transport operations. Further, the cooperative seeks to provide safe, convenient and reliable transport service to the riding public;

WHEREAS, the call for accreditation of Civil Society Organizations was caused by the Fifteenth Sangguniang Panlungsod in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No. 009 dated October 16, 2014 entitled: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE ACCREDITATION OF CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS (CSOs) IN THE CITY OF ORMOC" which governs the procedures for accreditation of legitimate organizations in the City of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian, after thorough review of the aforementioned four (4) separate applications for accreditation, finds that the same are in order, and the purposes of the sought accreditation are all directed to promote socio-economic development among its members through the establishment of a strong linkage with the local government unit in order for each organization to have a better access to the diverse programs and projects of the government that are beneficial to all sectors of the community;

WHEREAS, FURTHER, this august Body deems the application to be lawful being in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No. 009 hence, most deserving of favorable action by this Sanggunian;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Roiland H. Villasencio, Chairman, Committee on Cooperatives and Accreditation of Non-Government Organizations, severally seconded by Tomas R. Serafica, Nolito M. Quilang, Esteban V. Laurente, Vincent L. Rama, Gregorio G. Yrastorza III, Esteban V. Laurente, Lalaine A. Marcos and Peter M. Rodriguez; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass AN OMNIBUS RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FOUR (4) SEPARATE APPLICATIONS FOR ACCREDITATION WITH THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 009 DATED OCTOBER 16, 2014 OF THE FOLLOWING CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS, TO WIT:

- 3. UNITED ORMOC KANANGA TRANSPORT COOPERATIVE; AND
- 4. SABANG, VALENCIA, MATICA-A TRANSPORT COOPERATIVE (SAVAMTCO).
