

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE EXECUTIVE-
LEGISLATIVE AGENDA (ELA) FOR CALENDAR YEARS
2020-2022 OF THE CITY OF ORMOC.**

WHEREAS, through an Indorsement dated January 6, 2020, the City Mayor Richard I. Gomez has endorsed to this august Body for appropriate legislative action, the City Development Council (CDC) Resolution No. 12, Series of 2019, dated December 16, 2019 entitled: "A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CY 2020-2022 EXECUTIVE LEGISLATIVE AGENDA (ELA) AND REQUESTING THE HONORABLE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD FOR THE APPROVAL OF THE SAME";


