WHEREAS, this august Body was in receipt of an indorsement from the Office of the City Mayor dated January 7, 2020 requesting therein the passage of a resolution granting authority to the City Mayor to sign the attached Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to be entered into by and between the City Government of Ornioc and PLAN International, copy of the said MOA is hereto attached as "Annex Α";

WHEREAS, PLAN INTERNATIONAL is an international non-government organization that is working across seventy-nine countries to advance children's rights and equality for girls. The goal of PLAN is to make lasting improvements in the quality of life of deprived Filipino children and youth, their families and communities through programs that promote children's and youth's rights to learner-centered education, skills, and training for decent livelihoods;

WHEREAS, the City Legal Office upon review of the draft of the MOA, finds that the same is in order, not detrimental to the interests of the City, not contrary to law, morals and public policy, a copy of the said legal opinion is hereto attached as Annex "B" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, upon close and thorough review, this Sanggunian, finds that the MOA is not contrary to law and existing contracts, and that the purpose of such is aimed at developing and implementing learner-centered program that will address the needs of the young men and women in terms of education and decent employment, thus will promote inclusive growth in the City so therefore, most deserving of this august Body's full support and affirmative action to the same;
