A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. COMEZ OR THE ACTING CITY MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC (LGU-ORMOC) WITH REACT-OGMOK RELATIVE TO THE PROMOTION AND IMPLEMENTATION THE OF DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT (DRRM) PROGRAMS COVERED IN THE AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Mayor through an Endorsement dated October 02, 2019, forwarded to this august Body for consideration the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA), to be entered into by the Local Government Unit of Ormoc (LGU-Ormoc) with REACT-OGMOK for the promotion and implementation of DRRM Programs mentioned therein, a copy of the final MOA is hereto attached as Annex "A" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, the City of Ormoc is envisioned to be a leader in disaster preparedness and resiliency in Eastern Visayas through a collective undertaking for cooperation and coordination with the stakeholders in order to pool resources during calamities, especially in delivering a quick response on basic needs to remote areas;

WHEREAS, the REGIONAL EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE COMMUNICATIONS TEAM, INC. more commonly known as REACT PHILIPPINES, INC. (REACT) is considered as the largest civic communications organization in the country, composed of at least 12,000 regular members and extensions belonging to 163 groups located nationwide;

WHEREAS, the assistance of REACT is often sought especially when rapid information gathering, and dissemination is required, with members representing a cross section of the society, diverse in their vocations and unified by a common goal— to render humanitarian service;

WHEREAS, REACT- OGMOK, a subsidiary of REACT PHILIPPINES, INC. and an accredited Civil Society Organization (CSO) of the City of Ormoc, proactively serves by rendering assistance for public welfare particularly in rapid information gathering and dissemination and has been of vital importance in times of emergencies and calamities;

WHEREAS, the City of Ormoc recognizes the necessities of the assistance of CSOs in the City for the economic development and safety of the City and its inhabitants;

WHEREAS, REACT-OGMOK's role is to proactively serve as a partner in the promotion and execution of the City's DDRM programs through the proper offices concerned including the conduct and implementation of an annual program of activities that further develop and upgrade the skills of its members;

WHEREAS, the MOA provides mobilization of their resources to support knowledge management programs and plans, creation of MSAC Technical Working Group (TWG) comprising permanent representatives of members, attendance and participation in all MSAC activities and regular meeting for the assessment of the operations of LGRRC, and analysis and review of results of regularly conducted local governance knowledge management environment and the characteristics of its supply and demand in the region;

WHEREAS, the City Legal Office has issued a legal opinion dated October 01, 2019 stating that the MCA is in order, not detrimental to the interests of the City, not contrary to law, morals and public policy and recommends that an SP Resolution be secured for the Authority of the Mayor, a copy of the said letter is hereto attached as Annex 'B" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, the aforementioned letter has also recommended that the said MOA be endorsed to this Sanggunian for the issuance of a Resolution granting the City Mayor the authority to enter into the said Agreement in behalf of LGU-Ormoc pursuant to Section 22 (c) in relation to Section 455 (b) 1 (vi) and Section 458 (a) (2) (iii) of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, upon thorough examination of the subject MOA this Sanggunian finds that the same is found to clearly and plainly encapsulate the terms and conditions of the agreement of the parties thereto, including their specific roles and obligations towards the attainment of the lofty ends of the same;

WHEREAS, this august Body recognizes the importance of the subject MOA under consideration and this Sanggunian, upon thorough review, finds that overall it is favorable and advantageous to the City, particularly the benefits that it will give to its inhabitants in furtherance of the City Government's vision of leading in disaster preparedness and resiliency, therefore, is most deserving of this august Body's prompt and favorable consideration;

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THIS PRESENTS:

This memorandum of agreement is made and entered into by and between:

The LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC (LGU-ORMOC) with office address at Anubing St. Brgy. Cogon, Ormoc City and herein represented by the CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ, herein referred to as "City of Ormoc"

-and-

REACT OGMOK, a subsidiary of REACT PHILIPPINES, Inc., a non-stock, non-profit entity duly organized and existing under and by virtues of laws of the Republic of the Philippines with the office address at Barangay Camp Downes, Ormoc City represented herein by the REACT OGMOK Group Chief, SIMONE PETER KING AVILES hereinafter referred to as "REACT OGMOK".

-WITNESSETH-

WHEREAS, the City of Ormoc is envisioned to be a leader in disaster preparedness and resiliency in Eastern Visayas through a collective undertaking for cooperation and coordination with the stakeholders in order to pool resources during calamities, especially in delivering a quick response on basic needs to remote affected areas;

WHEREAS, the City of Ormoc recognizes the necessities of the assistance of the dependable Civic Social Organization (CSO) for the economic development and safety of the city;

WHEREAS, REACT- OGMOK, an accredited CSO of the City of Ormoc, proactively serves by rendering assistance for public welfare particularly in rapid information gathering and dissemination especially in times of emergencies and calamities;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the light of the foregoing premises, the PARTIES now enter in this agreement and commit to do the following in line with the abovementioned undertakings sought to be fulfilled:

Section 1: ON THE PART OF CITY OF ORMOC

 The City shall initiate work partnership in programs, project and activities to promote, strengthen and expand disaster risk reduction and management approach that is holistic, comprehensive, integrated, pro-active and participative by way of counter parting funds, manpower and resources of the LGU.

Section 2: ON THE PART OF THE REACT-OGMOK

- To serve proactively as a partner in the promotion and execution of the the City's disaster risk reduction and management programs through the City Mayor's Office, Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc (SP), City Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office (CDRRMO).
- 2. To conduct and implement an annual program of activities for the development and upgrading the skills of its members through the organization of events such as seminars, workshops and trainings, with the objective of promoting the goal of building communities resilient to natural disasters;
- 3. To foster a closer relationship, cooperation and understanding between Government and the Private sector affecting local and national concerns.
- 4. To continuously and actively endeavor and expand its membership base.

Section 3: JOINT UNDERTAKING OF THE CITY OF ORMOC AND REACT-

To meet regularly, if necessary, in order to take steps in the promotion and implementation of the DRRM programs covered in this agreement.

Section 4: EFFECTIVITY

This agreement shall take into effect from the date of its signing by the parties and shall be in full force and effect until either party decides to terminate the same after serving a 30-day written notice on the other party. Any amendment or modification of this agreement shall be made in writing and upon mutual consent by the parties concerned.


