RESOLUTION NO. 2020-074

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THAT THE BARANGAY ORDINANCE NO. 01 S. 2020 OF BARANGAY IPIL, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ORMOC TO ISSUE BARANGAY CLEARANCE AND COLLECT CORRESPONDING BARANGAY CLEARANCE FEE IN THE APPLICATION FOR ANY BUSINESS-RELATED TRANSACTIONS SUBJECT TO THE REMITTANCE OF THE AFORESAID FEES TO THE BARANGAY AND THE CONDITIONS HEREUNDER" UNDER REVIEW HAS BEEN FOUND TO BE IN CONFORMITY WITH EXISTING LAWS AND ORDINANCES, AND INTERPOSING NO OBJECTION TO ITS IMPLEMENTATION.

WHEREAS, the Fifteenth Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc received a copy of Ordinance from Barangay Ipil, entitled: "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ORMOC TO ISSUE BARANGAY CLEARANCE AND COLLECT CORRESPONDING BARANGAY CLEARANCE FEE IN THE APPLICATION FOR ANY BUSINESS-RELATED TRANSACTIONS SUBJECT TO THE REMITTANCE OF THE AFORESAID FEES TO THE BARANGAY AND THE CONDITIONS HEREUNDER". The copy of the Ordinance together with its attachments are hereto attached and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, the Ordinance is submitted to this Sanggunian pursuant to its review powers over enacted ordinances of all barangays within its territory as provided for in Section 57 and 458 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991" (LGC) in order to find out whether the subject Ordinances approved by the respective the Sangguniang Barangays are within the scope of its prescribed powers and also whether the same are in conformity with law and city ordinances;

WHEREAS, the enactment of the subject barangay ordinance by the concerned barangay is pursuant to EODB ACT of 2018 or Republic Act 11032, otherwise known as "An act Promoting Ease of Business and Efficient Delivery of Government Services, amending for the purpose of Republic Act No. 3485";

WHEREAS, Section 11 (f) of the above-mentioned Republic Act duly amended the Section 152 (c) of the Local Government Code and provides that "Barangay Clearances and Permits related to doing business shall be applied, issued and collected at the City/Municipality in accordance with the prescribed processing time of the said act. Provided, that the share in the collection shall be remitted to respective Barangays;

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian, in the exercise of its review powers, and after thorough examination of the said Barangay Ordinance, finds that the same is enacted for the purpose of raising revenues for the Barangay, which will in turn be utilized to deliver basic services and promote the general welfare and convenience of the Barangay constituents;

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian, finally finds that the Ordinance is valid and lawful and within the scope and authority of the Barangay, and therefore, manifests herein no objections to its implementation, and even urges that they be implemented immediately in order to speedily further the noble ends they seek for welfare of the Barangay;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Benjamin S. Pongos, Chairman, Committee on Laws and Ordinances, severally seconded by SP Members Roiland H. Villasencio, Tomas R. Serafica, Nolito M. Quilang, Peter M. Rodriguez, Vincent L. Rama, Gregorio G. Yrastorza III, Lalaine A. Marcos, Esteban V. Laurente and Joan Marbie C. Simbajon; be it
