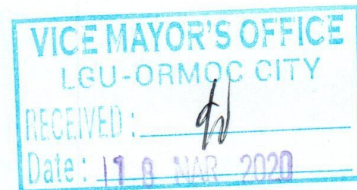

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-080

**AN OMNIBUS RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO
THE CITY MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THREE
SEPARATE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENTS (MOAs)
TO BE ENTERED INTO BY AND AMONG THE LOCAL
GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC CITY (LGU-ORMOC),
THE VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY (VSU), AND
THREE (3) FARMERS ASSOCIATIONS, NAMELY: (1)
CABINTAN LIVELIHOOD COMMUNITY
ASSOCIATION (CALCOA); (2) PIKAS LILOAN
UNITED FARMER ASSOCIATION (PLUFA); AND (3)
LAO SMALL FARMERS ASSOCIATION (LASFA), FOR
THE IMPLEMENTATION OF YOLANDA RECOVERY
AND REHABILITATION PROGRAM (YRRP) OF THE
DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE.**

WHEREAS, the 15th Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc received an endorsement letter from the Office of the City Mayor on February 03, 2020 requesting for an issuance of a Resolution granting the City Mayor the authority to enter into and sign Memorandum of Agreements (MOAs) to be entered into by and among the Local Government Unit of Ormoc City (LGU-ORMOC), the Visayas State University (VSU) and the three (3) Farmers Associations, a copy of the final MOAs are hereto attached as Annex "A", "B", and "C" and made integral parts hereof;

WHEREAS, the Department of Agriculture is the principal government agency mandated to develop the agriculture and fisheries sectors in the country through the provision of adequate and appropriate support services;

WHEREAS, to facilitate the return to normalcy of livelihood activities of the farmers, in the Yolanda affected areas, the Department of Agriculture established a Yolanda Recovery and Rehabilitation Program (YRRP) which provides timely and adequate financial assistance that aims to reconstruct and rehabilitate the livelihood of the farmers;

WHEREAS, the Visayas State University, as the implementing agency with its mission for the attainment of the highest quality of human capital and scientific knowledge for the sustained growth and development of agriculture, fisheries, forestry and agro-industry in the Visayas, is mandated to, among others, improve the productivity, profitability, equity and well-being of the Visayan farmers and their household members through ecologically sound natural resources management and to advocate effective policy formulation and management of rural development programs;

WHEREAS, the Department of Horticulture, College of Agriculture and Food Science-VSU aimed to implement a study on Production of Sweet Bell Pepper in Lowland and Highland Yolanda affected Areas and Relay Cropping of Glutinous Corn and Vegetable in Corn based Farming System Project for the development of high production system and promotes vegetable production for sufficient supply considering the weather extremes in Eastern Visayas;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Ormoc City is concerned of the well-being of its constituents by supporting efforts towards adaptation of modern farming technologies for the upliftment of their earning capacity;

WHEREAS, LASFA, a duly accredited farmer association of the Local Government Unit of Ormoc City, is an organization of farmers seeking to implement planned thrift and savings program among its members by initiating fund raising activities in order to uplift the current situation of life of its members;

WHEREAS, PLUFA, also an accredited farmer association of the Local Government Unit of Ormoc City, is an organization of farmers that seeks to promote mutual aid and protection to its members through the conduct of trainings on value chain analysis and cassava grates orientation;

WHEREAS, CALCOA, also an accredited farmer association of the Local Government Unit of Ormoc City, is an organization which seeks to uplift the socio-economic condition of the members through vegetation and other related activities;

WHEREAS, under their respective MOA's, CALCOA and LASFA will implement Production of Sweet Bell Pepper in Lowland and Highland Yolanda affected Areas Project while PLUFA will implement Relay Cropping of Glutinous Corn and Vegetable in Corn based Farming System Project with the assistance of the LGU-ORMOC and the VSU;

WHEREAS, the said farmer associations are interested to adopt technologies to increase the agricultural production of Farmer beneficiaries of those structures;

WHEREAS, after review of the draft MOAs by the City Legal Office, said office finds nothing legally objectionable recommending that the draft MOAs be endorsed to the Sangguniang Panlungsod for the issuance of a Resolution granting the City Mayor the authority to enter into and sign said MOAs, a copy of the letter is hereto attached as Annex "D" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, upon close and thorough review, this Sanggunian finds the aforementioned request by the City Mayor advantageous and for the best interest of the City and its inhabitants;

NOW THEREFORE, on joint motion of SP Member Serafica, Chairman-Committee on Agriculture, Fisheries and Agrarian Reform, and SP Member Nolito M. Quilang, Vice-Chairman - Committee on Laws and Ordinances, seconded by SP Members Esteban V. Laurente, Joan Marbie C. Simbajon, Peter M. Rodriguez, Eusebio Gerardo S. Penserga, Vincent L. Rama, Gregorio G. Yrastorza III, Lalaine A. Marcos and Roiland H. Villasencio; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass AN OMNIBUS RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THREE SEPARATE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENTS (MOAs) TO BE ENTERED INTO BY AND AMONG THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC CITY (LGU-ORMOC), THE VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY (VSU), AND THREE (3) FARMERS ASSOCIATIONS, NAMELY: (1) CABINTAN LIVELIHOOD COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION (CALCOA); (2) PIKAS LILOAN UNITED FARMER ASSOCIATION (PLUFA); AND (3) LAO SMALL FARMERS ASSOCIATION (LASFA), FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF YOLANDA RECOVERY AND REHABILITATION PROGRAM (YRRP) OF THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE;
