AN CMNIBUS RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ OR THE ACTING CITY MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE THREE (3) MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENTS (MOA) TO BE ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC CITY (LGU-ORMOC) AND THE THREE MEDICAL FACILITIES, NAMELY: SUGARCANE ORMOC PLANTERS ASSOCIATION-FARMERS MEDICAL CENTER (OSPA-FMC), ORMOC DOCTORS' HOSPITAL, AND CLINICA GATCHALIAN & HOSPITAL FOR THE INSTALLATION OF DIGITAL PROTOCOL 2-WAY RADIO COMMUNICATION.

WHEREAS, this Fifteenth Sangguniang Panlungsod was in receipt of an Indorsement dated February 24, 2020 from the Office of the City Mayor, endorsing a request for the issuance of an authority for the City Mayor to enter into and sign the three (3) Memorandum of Agreements (MOA) to be entered into by and between the Local Government Unit of Ormoc City (LGU-Ormoc) and the three medical facilities, namely: Ormoc Sugarcane Planters Association-Farmers Medical Center (OSPA-FMC), Ormoc Doctors' Hospital, and Clinica Gatchalian & Hospital for the installation of digital protocol 2-way radio communication;

WHEREAS, in an Opinion dated February 17, 2020, the City Legal Office found nothing legally objectionable in the three (3) Memorandum of Agreements (MOA) and that the same are not contrary to law, morals, public order, or public policy much less detrimental to the best interest of LGU-Ormoc City;

WHEREAS, as cited in the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA), the installation of a digital protocol 2-way radio communication device in the emergency room of the said hospitals, as part of the Early Warning System Program, will enable Ormoc City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (OCDRRMO) and the medical facilities an immediate response through a communication line readily available within its area of responsibility;

WHEREAS, Local Government Units are encouraged to develop programs that will provide knowledge and capacities that will effectively anticipate, respond, and recover from the impacts of likely, imminent, or current hazard events or conditions;

WHEREAS, Section 3(J) and (Q) of RA 10121 or otherwise known as "Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010" provides for disaster preparedness and early warning systems as a step to prevent or if not alleviate the effects of hazard events or conditions;

WHEREAS, Section 4(9) of RA 10121 IRR states that one of the LDRRMO's function is to "Conduct continuous disaster monitoring and mobilize instrumentalities and entities of the LGUs, CSOs, private groups and organized volunteers, to utilize their facilities and resources for the protection and preservation of life and properties during emergencies in accordance with existing policies and procedures";

WHEREAS, Section 3(13) of RA 10121 IRR states that the LDRRMO shall "Maintain a database of human resource, equipment, directories, and location of critical infrastructures and their capacities such as hospitals and evacuation centers";

WHEREAS, Section 4(14) of RA 10121 states that the LDRRMO will "Develop, strengthen, and operationalize mechanisms for partnership or networking with the private sector, CSOs, and volunteer groups";
