


**A RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY
MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ OR THE ACTING CITY
MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE
MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH IÑAKI
A. LARRAZABAL ENTERPRISE INC. RELATIVE TO THE
IMPLEMENTATION OF THE RESIDENT RECOVERY
PROGRAM.**

WHEREAS, this Fifteenth Sangguniang Panlungsod was in receipt of an Indorsement dated May 11, 2020 from the Office of the City Mayor, endorsing a request for the issuance of a Resolution granting the City Mayor or the Acting City Mayor the authority to enter into and sign the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with Iñaki A. Larrazabal Enterprise Inc. relative to the implementation of the resident recovery program, a copy of the MOA is hereto attached as "ANNEX A" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, Iñaki A. Larrazabal Enterprise Inc., a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the Philippines, with principal address at Ormoc City, is hereinafter referred to as the COMPANY;

WHEREAS, recognizing the right of stranded Ormocanons to come home, Executive Order No. 54 establishing the guidelines for the return of stranded Ormocanons, was issued;

WHEREAS, it is mandated in the guidelines that all stranded Ormocanons coming from COVID-19 positive areas must be brought to a quarantine facility upon entry to the port of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, the said EO provides that returning residents may have the option to be quarantined at a hotel supervised by the LGU-ORMOC, for which all expenses of said quarantine (accommodations, food and all costs incurred during and by reason of his/her stay) shall be for the account of the resident or his parent/guardian;

WHEREAS, the COMPANY is amenable to accept these residents and establish the IAL Lodge located in Bonifacio St., corner Burgos St., Ormoc City as a quarantine facility of the LGU-ORMOC;

WHEREAS, LGU-ORMOC and the COMPANY hereby agreed that the latter's IAL LODGE shall be used as quarantine facility for stranded residents who wish to be quarantined in a hotel at their own expense, under the supervision and control of the former;

WHEREAS, the subject MOA clearly and plainly encapsulates the terms and conditions of the agreement of the parties thereto, including their specific roles and obligations towards the attainment of the lofty ends of the same, and this Sanggunian, upon thorough review, finds that the same is entered into for the best interests of the City and its constituents thereby maintaining a COVID free environment, and therefore, is most deserving of this august Body's prompt and favorable consideration;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Jasper M. Lucero, Chairman, Committee on Good Government & Oversight, severally seconded by SP Members Tomas R. Serafica, Roiland H. Villasencio, Eusebio Gerardo S. Penserga, Peter M. Rodriguez, Vincent L. Rama, Gregorio G. Yrastorza III, Lalaine A. Marcos, Esteban V. Laurente and Joan Marbie C. Simbajon; be it

GOMEZ OR THE ACTING CITY MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH IÑAKI A. LARRAZABAL ENTERPRISE INC. RELATIVE TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE RESIDENT RECOVERY PROGRAM;



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This agreement made and entered into this _____ day of _____ 2020 in Ormoc City, Philippines, by and among:

THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC (LGU ORMOC), with address at Aunubing St., Cogon, Ormoc City, herein represented by MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ, hereinafter referred to as "LGU ORMOC"; AND

INAKI A. LARRAZABAL ENTERPRISES INC., a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the Philippines, with principal address at Ormoc City, represented by MARIA MILAGROS L. RIZARRI, hereinafter referred to as the COMPANY;

WITNESSETH, that:

WHEREAS, recognizing the right of stranded Ormocanons to come home, Executive Order _____ establishing the guidelines for the return of stranded Ormocanons, was issued;

WHEREAS, it is mandated in the guidelines that all stranded Ormocanons who come from COVID- positive areas must be brought to a quarantine facility upon entry to the port of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, the EO provides that returning residents may have the option to be quarantined at a hotel supervised by the LGU ORMOC, for which all expenses of said quarantine (accommodations, food and all costs incurred during and by reason of his/ her stay) shall be for the account of the resident or his parent/ guardian;

WHEREAS, the COMPANY is amenable to accept these residents and establish the IAL Lodge located in Bonifacio St., corner Burgos St., Ormoc City as a quarantine facility of the LGU ORMOC;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in considerations of the foregoing premises and covenants and undertakings hereinafter set forth, parties hereto have agreed as follows:

ARTICLE I. OBJECTIVE

The **LGU ORMOC** and **COMPANY** hereby agreed that the latter's IAL LODGE shall be used as quarantine facility for stranded residents who wish to be quarantined in a hotel at their own expense, under the supervision and control of the LGU;

ARTICLE II: RESPONSIBILITIES OF PARTIES

Consistent with the properties of this Agreement, the LGU shall:

1. Coordinate and provide the names of the returning residents who wish to be quarantined at IAL Lodge.
2. Provide transport for the designated returning residents to IAL Lodge from the port.
3. Provide CSU personnel who will guard the entrance of the hotel aside from the private security guard of the Hotel and medical personnel who will daily monitor the health of the returning residents.

For its part, the COMPANY shall:

1. Designate a room for every returning resident that is supplied by the LGU to be quarantined and shall inform the latter of the designated room number for every person.
2. Provide food as may be requested by the returning resident, for his/ her account.
3. Disinfect the rooms designated for the returning residents before and after the quarantine period.
4. Allow all access to LGU personnel and staff who will conduct the daily monitoring of the quarantined residents.
5. Provide PPE to all the hotel staff of the company and ensure that they are worn by their staff at all times when inside the hotel.
6. Assist the LGU in ensuring that quarantine protocol is followed and shall report the LGU any returning residents who violate any provision of the protocol.
7. Hold the LGU Ormoc free and harmless for all costs of accommodations, food and other expenses as may be incurred during and by reason of the stay by the returning resident at the IAL Lodge.
